faith. Whether it is the conditions that established "Protestantism" over five hundred years ago or the matter of slavery two hundred years ago. In fact, we could return to the First Century where Christian sects such as Judaizers and Gnosticism caused division."

DavidSon shares what persons can do or think to help them through this experience the world is witnessing today.

"Historian, George Satayana said in part, 'those who forget history are doomed to repeat it.' The Bible records: 'That which has been is that which will be, And that which has been done is that which will be.' Ecclesiastes 1:9.

First, this condition is not new. What we're witnessing has always been a test of the historical faith. More importantly, the historical faith warns of conditions where millions claiming the faith would be aligned with questionable governing authorities. Finally, many of the terms embraced dearly, such as Christian, Church, Israel elapses or expire. The historical faith recorded these facts and declared them thousands of years in advance. This circumstance will not in any way hurt or hinder the ultimate mission. Those who are concerned and those connected to governing authority can both stand resolute.
