
David Hillberg Confronts California Politics in New Book Election Deniers: Observations of a Candidate

Before politics, Hillberg lived a life built around service and technical skill. He served in the U.S. Army as a Scout Helicopter Repairer, worked across multiple sectors of aviation as an inspector and pilot, and later entered the entertainment industry as both a performer and active union member. These experiences gave him a wide-angle view of how organizations — whether government, industry, or union — operate behind the scenes.

The book connects those experiences with his critique of politics today. He writes not as a career politician but as someone who spent years in environments where accountability and responsibility carried real weight. His voice is both personal and pointed, shaped by time in the military, aviation hangars, and campaign rallies alike.

An Urgent Conversation

Hillberg's work arrives at a moment when debates over election integrity and government accountability are central to national discourse. *Election Deniers: Observations of a Candidate* is not a detached policy analysis, nor is it a simple campaign memoir. Instead, it is a first-hand account that blends observation with personal testimony, offering a perspective rooted in lived experience.

While the book critiques the state of governance, it also calls on citizens to take their role seriously. Hillberg argues that lasting change cannot come from party insiders alone, but requires vigilance, transparency, and civic participation.

Author Biography

David Hillberg was born in California into a family deeply tied to motorsports and aviation. From a young age he pursued civic and technical work, training in fire technology before serving in the U.S. Army as a Scout Helicopter Repairer. His aviation career spanned positions with airlines, the Los Angeles Sheriff's Aero Bureau, the U.S. Border Patrol Air Unit, and Gulfstream Aerospace, where he worked as both an inspector and pilot.

Hillberg also built a parallel career in Hollywood, appearing in film productions and taking part in union activities during the Screen Actors Guild and AFTRA merger. These varied experiences deepened his perspective on how institutions, whether in aviation or entertainment, often failed to live up to their responsibilities.

In 2021 he entered the gubernatorial recall race in California, an experience that inspired his latest book. *Election Deniers: Observations of a Candidate* reflects his lifelong interest in civic duty and his continuing concern with the direction of governance in the United States.
