

Hybrid Learning Model: How APEX EA Combines Online + Hands-On Labs to Prepare Global Caregivers

TESDA-aligned program combines online modules and practical labs to equip caregivers with the skills and confidence for international deployment.

Under the campaign “Train. Care. Go Global.” the newly-launched training centre merges virtual theory modules

with immersive hands-on labs to produce caregivers ready for global deployment.

The programme is aligned with the requirements of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), which is actively encouraging blended and hybrid learning approaches across technical-vocational education and training in the Philippines. Whereas traditional training often relied solely on classroom presence, Apex's model combines asynchronous online study, scheduled live sessions, and real-time in-person practical training.

"The caregiving sector demands both the knowledge and the physical-skills to perform in dynamic international work environments," said Ivy, CEO of Apex Employment Agency. "That's why our hybrid approach gives our candidates the flexibility to learn online and the structured lab time they need to build confidence in real care scenarios."

Online modules cover foundational competencies such as workplace communication, occupational safety and health standards, language readiness and cultural orientation, subjects typically taught in classroom settings. Meanwhile, the hands-on labs address core competencies like elderly/infant care, managing persons with special needs, emergency first-aid and safe environment maintenance, competencies highly valued by overseas employers. Such blended curriculum design mirrors international recommendations for caregiver training that emphasise "interactive, practical and experiential" methods.

Apex's trainees benefit from flexible scheduling to accommodate working individuals, greater access to resources through its online learning management system, and the experiential benefit of on-site labs that reflect real-world care environments. As a result, technical skills are reinforced with cultural and behavioural readiness, a combination that industry data shows is becoming essential for global caregiver deployment.

Enrolment for the first batch of the hybrid programme begins in March 2026 and is open to applicants from the National Capital Region, CALABARZON and other provincial centres. A limited number of scholarship slots and flexible payment options are available to support financially-eligible candidates.
