The 'preproduction' stage of mapping out the entire system architecture, a discipline I learned directly from cinema, was crucial to the project's success."

Born on January 26, 2005, in Bijar, Kurdistan province, Ali Moradi Dev represents a new wave of Iranian professionals who are leveraging cross-disciplinary skills to make a global impact. 
