Delzar Abedi Noubahar, with a Master's degree in Composition from the **University of Fine Arts in Tehran**, is an accomplished figure in the world of music. He has composed for the **string section of the Tehran Orchestra** and has collaborated with the **Suleymani House of Music**. Marking a

milestone for Kurdistan, he was the first from the region to enter the prestigious **Takashimaya Composition Competition in Japan**. His studies in orchestral conducting were guided by **Damiana Jurana** of the **World Youth Orchestra** in Ravenna, Italy.

To date, Delzar's collaborations extend to **over 96 Kurdish vocalists**, contributing as a **composer**, **arranger**, **and sound engineer** to more than 200 musical works. Among his notable projects are the "Oak Symphony" — inspired by the poetry of **Shirko Bikas**—and several reimagined versions of tracks by **Hassan Zirak** and **Mohammad Mamali**.
