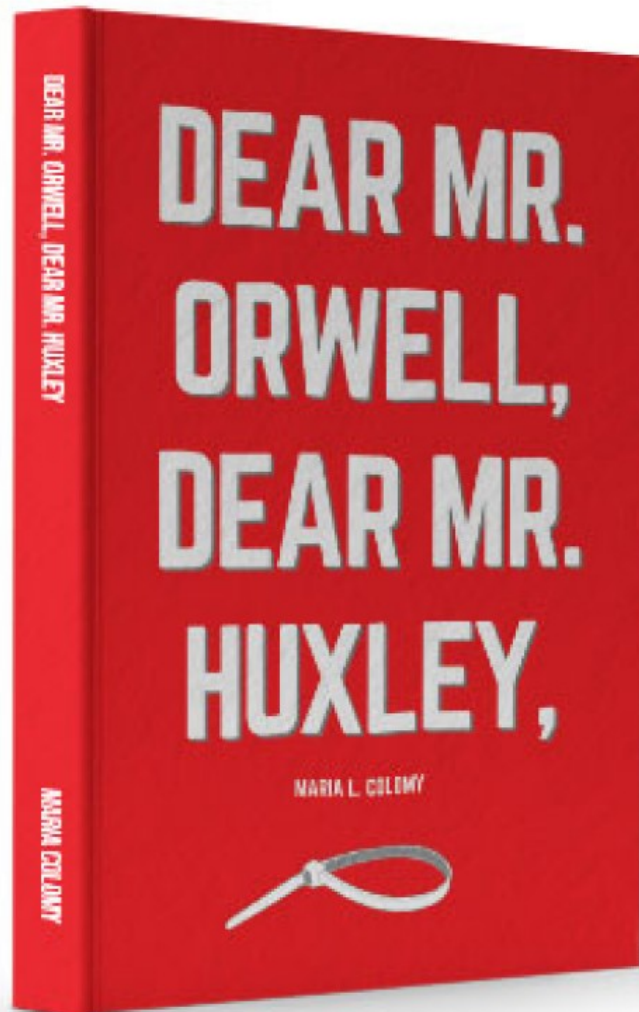


New Book "Dear Mr. Orwell, Dear Mr. Huxley" Hailed as "Uncomfortably Real and Brilliantly Written"
