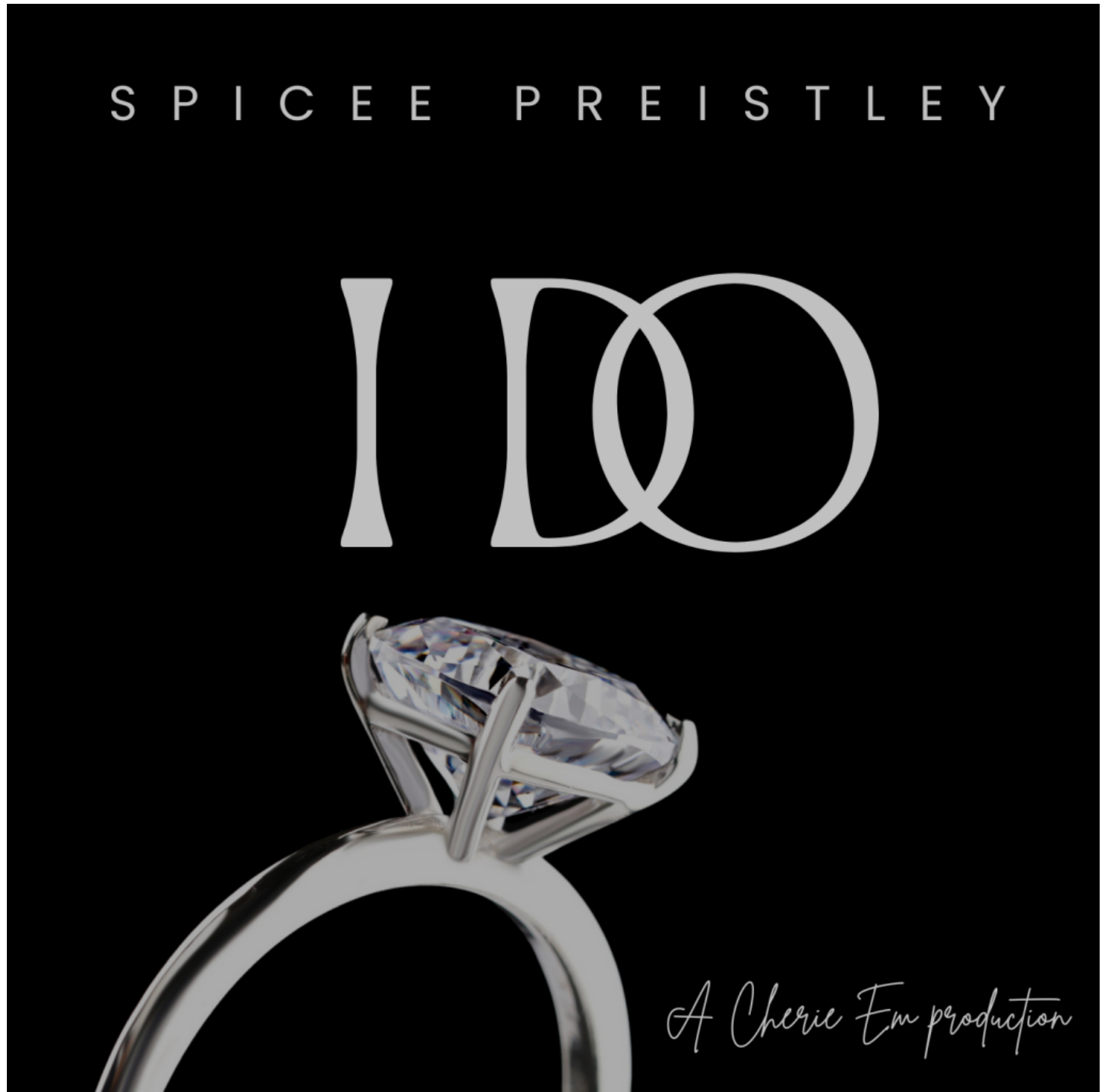


Save the Date: Spicee Prestley's "I Do" Drops 10/10 — The New Wedding Anthem for Lovers Everywhere
