
Scott M. Alexander Releases Q3 2025 Digital Transformation Insights Report: "Convergence = Resilience"

Top signals: tougher AI guardrails, cloud+AI ops convergence, KEV-as-a-KPI, and power as the new platform

Key findings

- **Governance** → **enforcement:** National AI laws, FTC/DOJ attention, and NIST/CISA overlays are moving requirements from advice to evidence, directly shaping product and rollout plans.
- Cloud + Al ops converged: Agent frameworks and portability policies shortened the path from PoC to production, with sovereign/edge patterns maturing.
- **Cyber = evidence of resilience:** KEV entries and emergency directives made patch-closure rates board-visible; disclosure pressure persists.
- **Power is the new platform:** DOE/PJM moves and multi-GW on-site generation pushed energy strategy into every scale plan; capex continues to flow into power-compute flywheels.
- **Real deployments scaled:** Hospitals expanded ambient AI; banks formalized AI leadership; retail advanced CV+robotics from pilots to managed services.

What leaders should do in Q4

- Governance as a sales asset: Publish a lightweight control catalog and evidence pack for bids.
- Portability re-price: Update DR/egress TCO; run a live failover.
- **KEV-as-KPI**: Weekly exec view of closure % with owners and due dates.
- Curtailment annexes: Add to infra SOWs; pre-label shiftable workloads.
- Scale only proven use cases: Advance those hitting ROI gates; sunset the rest.
