## **America Down: A Post-Apocalyptic Story of Loss, Resilience, and Teen Mental Health**

The project also carries the mark of rising industry talent **William Atticus Parker**, the film's producer and casting director. Parker recently made headlines for his 2025 independent film Atrabilious, starring **Jeffrey Wright, Alec Baldwin, Mark Boone Junior, and Whoopi Goldberg**, which was acquired byBuffalo 8 for a late 2025 release. Known for bringing A-list talent to independent features, Parker's involvement signals serious momentum for America Down and its growing potential for major studio interest.

Also attached to the project is actor and producer **Lucas Harmon**, who portrays the lead role in America Down. Together, the team brings both artistic integrity and cinematic ambition to a story that touches deeply on the human experience. Now, the filmmakers are turning to the public for support through an upcoming Indiegogo crowdfunding campaign. The goal is to expand this proof of concept into a full-length feature, shooting across Connecticut and Nashville in May 2026. Every contribution brings the project one step closer to shining a light on teenage mental health, isolation, and hope, themes that resonate now more than ever.

For this small but determined team, <u>America Down</u> is not just a film. It is proof that independent creators with a shared vision and relentless spirit can create something truly powerful. The hope is to move audiences worldwide and secure broader distribution, whether in theaters or on streaming platforms.
