
LexDo.it raises €1.7 million to become the go-to platform for starting and managing new businesses

Italy is one of the largest markets in Europe, with 4.5 million active businesses (Eurostat), yet remains among the most complex and costly countries to start one. Opening costs and administrative requirements can exceed €4,000 on average. LexDo.it currently serves over 400,000 users and has already helped more than 6,500 new businesses get started, saving up to €3,000 in the first year compared to traditional channels.
