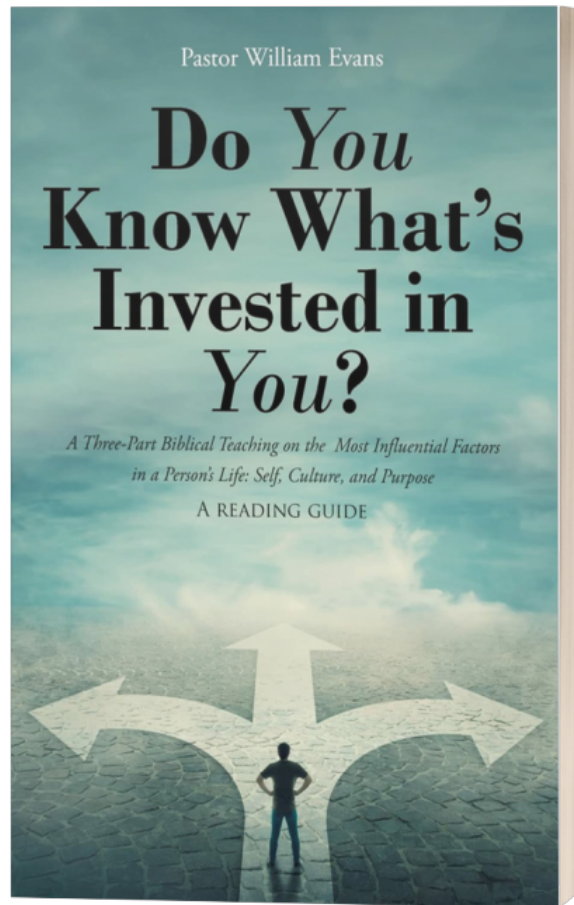


New Biblical Guidebook Explores Identity, Influence, and Divine Purpose
