The public University Health system has likewise launched its largest expansion in history – including two full-service hospitals on the South and Northeast sides – with one new campus planned to open with 166 beds (designed for future expansion to 286 beds) by 2027. Even the area's mental healthcare

infrastructure is growing: in April 2024, Texas officials opened a state-of-the-art 300-bed San Antonio State Hospital, a \$357 million replacement facility that modernized an aging complex dating back to the 1890s.

From large medical centers to smaller neighborhood clinics, San Antonio's healthcare footprint is expanding – and with it comes a greater volume of spaces that must be cleaned, disinfected, and kept in compliance with health standards every day

Post-Pandemic Emphasis on Infection Control

The COVID-19 pandemic dramatically raised public awareness about infection control and sanitation in healthcare settings. Hospitals and clinics in San Antonio introduced enhanced cleaning protocols – from more frequent disinfection of high-touch surfaces to investing in new technologies such as UV light or electrostatic sprayers – to curb the spread of the coronavirus.

This heightened focus on hygiene has proven long-lasting. 
