

Alain Nu 'The Man Who Knows' Reveals Top 10 Paranormal Events of 2025

Mysterious lights, secret UFO programs, and cryptic sightings make this year unforgettable for the unexplained.

"People are fascinated by the unknown because it challenges them to think beyond what they've been taught. 2025 has shown us that mystery is alive and well."

Alain Nu's Top 10 Paranormal Events of 2025

1. UFO Sighting Grounds Flights

In February 2025, Gaziantep Airport in Turkey briefly halted departures after pilots reported an unidentified flying object near 10,000 feet. The object was not detected on radar. Officials later suggested a drone, though online speculation claimed evidence of extraterrestrial contact, with some asserting "contact is definitely happening before 2027."

2. U.S. House Task Force Releases UAP Video

September 2025 saw the House Oversight Task Force on the Declassification of Federal Secrets hold a public hearing on Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena (UAPs). Lawmakers reviewed sightings and maps, heard testimony from military veterans and journalists, and highlighted the need for transparency, data collection, and whistleblower protections. New footage showed a UAP seemingly unaffected by a military missile.

3. UAP Sightings in Australia

In Western Australia's Midwest and Goldfields regions, residents have frequently reported strange lights moving in formations in the night sky. Perth Observatory also received inland reports, and defense officials confirmed no military activity. Experts debated potential explanations, but the sightings remain unexplained. Additionally, the "Dudley Dorito" triangular UFO was seen again over the West Midlands, UK, continuing decades of local unexplained sightings.

4. Lake Michigan Triangle

The Lake Michigan Triangle, spanning Ludington, Manitowoc, and Benton Harbor, has continued to attract attention for mysterious ship and aircraft disappearances and UAP reports. Speculation includes extreme weather, magnetic anomalies, or extraterrestrial activity, keeping the region's mysteries alive.

5. Mysterious Underwater Objects

In October 2025, a UFO tracking app documented over 9,000 Unidentified Submersible Objects (USOs) near U.S. coastlines. Hundreds were seen within five miles of shore, some described as hovering or moving underwater, raising questions about unexplained coastal activity.

6. UFO-Nuclear Connection Flashes

A scientific study published in October 2025 analyzed 1950s astronomical data and found a statistical link between transient sky flashes, above-ground nuclear tests, and UAP sightings. Transient objects were 45% more likely to appear near nuclear detonations, suggesting previously unidentified atmospheric effects.

7. Paranormal Activity at Connecticut Inn

In an October interview with WTIC-TV FOX61 reporter Kaye Paddyfote, employees at the historic Captain Daniel Packer Inn in Mystic, Connecticut, described ghost sightings, apparitions, and unexplained phenomena, adding to the inn's long-standing reputation as a haunted site.

8. Top-Secret UFO Research Disclosed

In November 2025, UFO investigative journalist George Knapp revealed details of a covert U.S. government program investigating extraterrestrial phenomena. The program produced classified reports suggesting possible non-human intelligence, reigniting public interest in government UFO research.

9. Interstate 80 Bigfoot Sighting

A driver in Centre County, Pennsylvania, reported seeing a large, bipedal creature resembling Bigfoot crossing Interstate 80 in early October 2025. The sighting was deemed credible by the Bigfoot Field Researchers Organization, generating local discussion about unexplained wildlife.

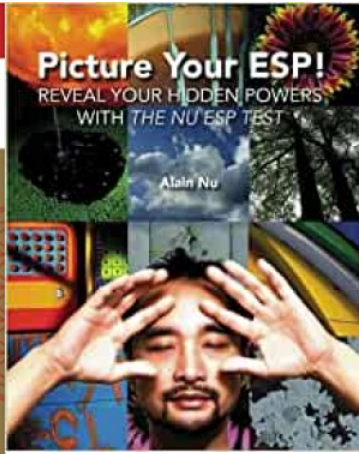
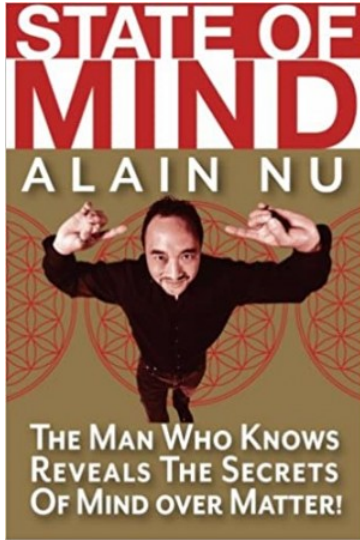
10. Extraterrestrial Contact in New Mexico & More UFOs

A new documentary released in November 2025, "The Age of Disclosure," claims former President George H.W. Bush told astrophysicist Eric Davis of a 1964 encounter with extraterrestrials at Holloman Air Force Base in New Mexico, including sightings of three spacecraft and contact with an alien being.

Looking ahead, Alain Nu predicts that 2026 could be a breakthrough year for paranormal disclosure. "The reports, research, and sightings we've seen in 2025 are just the beginning," Nu said. "Next year, I believe we'll see governments, scientists, and the public acknowledging phenomena that were once dismissed. Whether it's UFOs, unexplained submersibles, or other mysteries, 2026 will be a pivotal year for expanding our understanding of the unknown."
