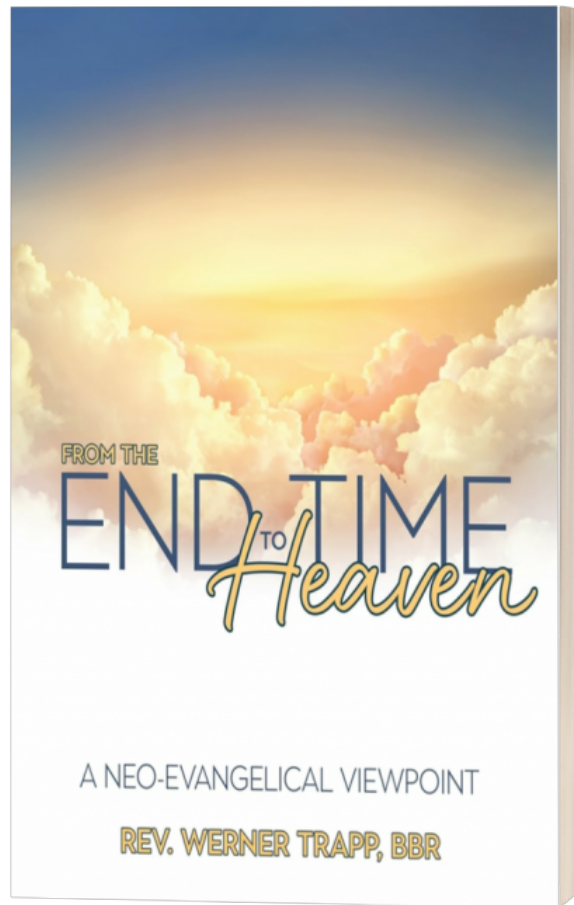


“From the End Time to Heaven: A Neo-Evangelical Viewpoint” Earns Recognition from the US Review of Books
