The infrastructure supporting remote gigs is scaling quickly too, with the U.S. freelance platforms market estimated at \$1.17 billion in 2023 and projected to grow at about 13.1% CAGR through 2030.

“People are choosing remote side hustles for the same reasons companies are embracing flexible talent: efficiency, autonomy, and global reach,” Sārmiņš said. “The opportunity is real, and the tools to start have never been more accessible.”
