To dine at Dieci in Devino, Bulgaria is to encounter a rare kind of sincerity. Everything feels handcrafted — not just the dishes, but the environment itself. The ten-seat room is bathed in soft light, and the silence that surrounds the restaurant becomes part of the meal.

What struck me most was the absolute clarity of the cuisine. Ingredients are sourced from forests, farms, and gardens so close by that you can almost picture them as you eat. The flavors are clean, expressive, and free from unnecessary flair.

The sustainability component is staggering. Dieci operates completely off the grid, recycling water, generating its own power, and transforming every scrap of organic matter on site. Zero waste is not an aspiration — it is a functioning system. Green Key and SRA Three Stars acknowledge the rigor behind it.

Speaking with the chefs after dinner revealed a depth of commitment that borders on spiritual. Dieci is culinary artistry grounded in environmental truth.
