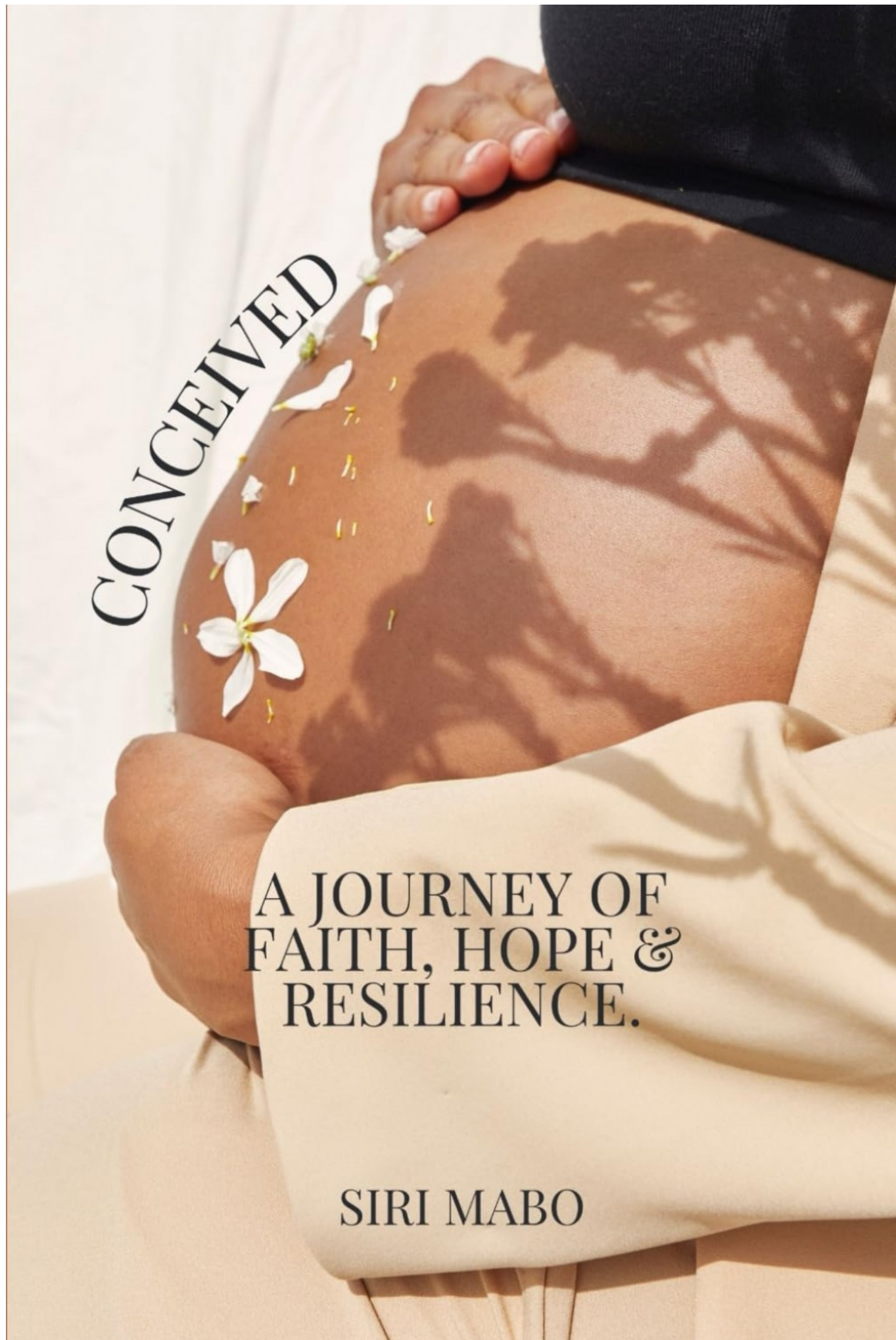


From Diagnosis to Miracle: A Nurse's Memoir of Faith, Family, and the Power of Sibling Sacrifice

Mabo's story unfolds across years of hospital rooms, unanswered questions, and moments that tested every part of her identity as a mother, wife, and believer. While navigating sickle cell disease with her twins, her older child was diagnosed with autism, learning firsthand how layered and demanding motherhood can become when multiple needs converge at once.

Conceived offers an honest look into the emotional and spiritual toll of caring for children with complex medical needs while holding a family together. Mabo writes about the strain placed on marriage, the weight of constant vigilance, and the quiet strength required to keep moving forward when outcomes are uncertain. Her faith is not presented as a slogan, but as a lifeline sustained through long nights, difficult conversations, and decisions that carried lifelong consequences.

At the center of this story is a rare and sacred truth. In the moments that mattered most, siblings became each other's lifeline. One twin received a lifesaving bone marrow transplant in 2021, made possible through donation from an older sibling, and became sickle cell-free. Years later, the family's journey led to the blessing of a fourth child, whose life became the answer that allowed the second twin to receive a bone marrow transplant and become sickle cell free in 2024.

What emerges is not simply a medical memoir, but a portrait of four siblings permanently bound by love, sacrifice, and courage. *Conceived* speaks to families who have lived in waiting rooms, parents who have wrestled with impossible decisions, and anyone who has had to trust faith and perseverance when certainty was out of reach.

Beyond the pages of her book, Mabo continues her advocacy through the *Conceived* Podcast on YouTube, where she shares conversations rooted in faith, resilience, and the quiet strength families draw on during medical and emotional trials. Building on these experiences, she and her husband, Divine Mabo, established The Mabo Foundation for Autism and Sickle Cell Disease (MFASCD) to raise awareness and provide meaningful support to families navigating similar paths.
