"We aim to reframe the narrative that hilarious stories from drunken encounters aren't wasted—they can educate, inspire growth, and entertain."

Recent studies, including qualitative research published in the [Journal of Substance Use and Addiction Treatment](#), highlight how humor helps individuals in recovery reframe dark moments, lower tension, and foster connections in settings like 12-step programs. Experts describe the thoughtful use of humor in addiction recovery as "worthy of further investigation," noting its potential to promote laughter, learning, and mirth while aiding sobriety journeys.

According to the latest data from the [National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism](#) (NIAAA) and the 2024 National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH), more than 27 MILLION Americans ages 12 and older had alcohol use disorder (AUD) in the past year — underscoring the urgent need for innovative, accessible approaches to promoting alcohol abstinence.

A [Gallup poll conducted in August 2025](#) found that alcohol consumption among Americans had fallen to record lows.
