

Hon. Andrew H. Card and Hon. Leon Panetta to Appear on Next Steps Forward with Dr. Chris Meek for 250th Show

He also founded the Panetta Institute for Public Policy to inspire civic engagement and educate future leaders.

Card and Panetta are deeply committed to ensuring that the lessons of September 11 are remembered, understood, and passed on to future generations through their work with The 9/11 Legacy Foundation.
