

Independent Label Jaeigh Gallagher Records Advances Supernova Global Auditions and Docuseries

A grassroots, artist-led initiative enters its next development phase while preparing a trainee-focused bootcamp and behind-the-scenes docuseries.



Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania Jan 15, 2026 ([IssueWire.com](http://www.IssueWire.com)) - Jaeigh Gallagher Records, LLC (JGR), an independent artist-development label, announced continued progress on *Supernova*, a global co-ed music group initiative currently in its pre-debut training and evaluation phase.

Founded by multidisciplinary artist and entrepreneur Jaeigh Gallagher, JGR was created to offer an alternative to traditional industry pipelines by prioritizing accessibility, transparency, and creative growth. *Supernova* reflects that mission, bringing together emerging performers from diverse backgrounds through a structured online bootcamp model that emphasizes skill development rather than upfront financial barriers.

The program's training phase officially begins March 16, 2026, and runs through late June. During this period, selected trainees, referred to internally as "ASCANs," a term borrowed from NASA astronaut training programs, participate in self-paced educational modules, collaborative challenges, and scheduled virtual evaluations. Judges and mentors provide written feedback and limited live Zoom sessions, allowing participants from around the world to engage without relocation or excessive time commitments.

Importantly, JGR confirms that participation in *Supernova* does not require any trainee fees. The label does not request payment, fundraising, or sensitive personal data from participants beyond legally required documentation for program eligibility. All business credentials for Jaeigh Gallagher Records, LLC, including licensing and registration, are publicly accessible through standard business databases.

In tandem with the bootcamp, JGR is developing an independently produced docuseries that will chronicle the formation of *Supernova* from auditions through selection. The project is currently supported through a combination of personal funding, community-based fundraising efforts, and in-kind contributions. This model reflects the label's commitment to remaining independent while building sustainable creative infrastructure.

"Building something new in the independent space requires patience and trust," said Gallagher. ***"We're choosing to grow responsibly, keep our processes visible, and protect both our artists and our business as we move forward."***

Jaeigh Gallagher Records also confirmed that the program accommodates trainees of varying ages, with additional safeguards and parental involvement for minors, in accordance with standard industry and legal practices.

As *Supernova* advances into its next phase, JGR continues to focus on artist development, documentation, and long-term planning rather than rapid commercialization. Further announcements, including trainee milestones and docuseries updates, will be shared through official channels.
