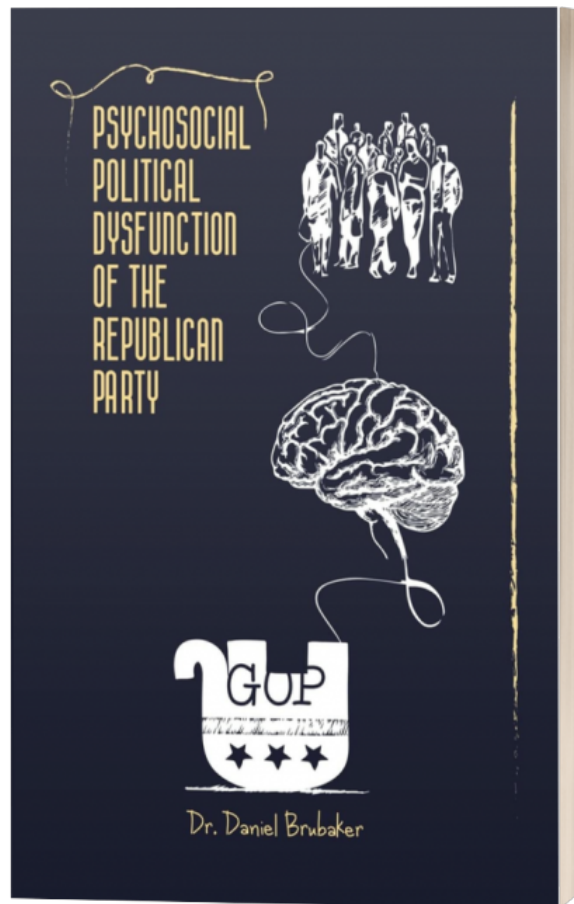


Political Psychology and Party Identity Explored in New Release by Dr. Daniel B. Brubaker
