## Step-by-Step Solutions

**Verify Your Payroll Subscription Status** Start by confirming your payroll subscription is active and current. Go to Employees > My Payroll Service > Manage Service Key in QuickBooks. Check the subscription status and expiration date. If your subscription has expired, you'll need to renew it before processing payroll. Verify that your payment method on file with Intuit is current and hasn't been declined. For subscription verification or renewal assistance, call **1-888-394-9046** for immediate help.

**Update Payroll Tax Tables** Outdated tax tables often prevent payroll processing. Navigate to Employees > Get Payroll Updates and select "Download Entire Update." ### **Why does QuickBooks say my payroll subscription is inactive when I just renewed it?**

**Answer:** Even after renewing your payroll subscription, QuickBooks may take time to sync with Intuit's servers and recognize the active status. First, close QuickBooks completely and reopen it to force a refresh. Go to Employees > My Payroll Service > Account/Billing Information and click "Sync Account" to manually update subscription status. Ensure your internet connection is stable during this process. Clear your QuickBooks cache by pressing F2 to open Product Information, noting your subscription key, then going to Help > Reset Intuit Account to force re-authentication. If QuickBooks still shows your subscription as inactive after these steps, there may be a billing issue, account mismatch, or technical problem requiring immediate resolution. ### **Why are my payroll taxes calculating incorrectly in QuickBooks?**
