


Chicago Entrepreneur Thaddeus Jones-McCall Debuts Stories of a Black Twin Flame

a Narrative Poetry Collection Exploring Love, Identity, and Spiritual Connection

The collection draws on Jones-McCall's own life and explores the kind of emotional experiences that are difficult to put into words and even harder to let go of.

The concept of the twin flame sits at the center of the collection, a connection that goes beyond romance and functions more like a mirror, reflecting both the best and most difficult parts of who you are. Jones-McCall approaches this with honesty rather than idealism, capturing the tension of two people who feel deeply drawn to each other while being equally challenged by what that closeness reveals. The poems cover that full spectrum, from the pull of desire to the quiet difficulty of surrender, and the spiritual disorientation that can come when a relationship forces you to look at yourself differently.

Across the collection, individual poems take on different emotional registers. "*Only Temporary*" reflects

on time and the grief of moments that cannot be recovered. "*Black Phoenix*" is a direct celebration of Black womanhood, tracing a lineage of strength and resilience passed through generations. "*Surrender*" deals with the frustration of wanting closeness with someone whose walls remain up, and the quiet resignation that follows when you realize you cannot force another person to let you in. Taken together, the poems build an arc that moves through longing and loss toward something closer to self-understanding.

Jones-McCall started writing this collection from a recognition that the emotions tied to love and identity are often too layered for ordinary conversation to hold. "We're taught to summarize powerful emotions with something like 'I love you,' and that phrase has to carry everything," he said. "This book exists to give voice to the feelings we struggle to articulate, the ones that sit in silence, waiting to be understood." The poems reflect that intention, prioritizing emotional specificity over broad declarations and giving space to the kind of feeling that rarely gets named directly.
