


## **Former London Detective Gary Powell Uncovers a Chilling Underground Truth in Mind the Killer**

Set within a rarely seen policing environment, *Mind the Killer* delivers a relentless pace, sharp dialogue, and escalating tension that drives toward a shocking, unforgettable conclusion. More than a crime novel, it is a dark exploration of fear, obsession, and the enduring power of vengeance.

**Gary Powell** is a former London detective who served with the **British Transport Police for thirty-three years**, working on numerous major investigations including murder and terrorism. Toward the end of his career, he became a recognized expert in **behavioral detection**, training police officers worldwide to identify criminal behavior and terrorist intent.

Powell is a public speaker on historical crime, the author of several nonfiction titles, a **member of the Crime Writers' Association**, and a guide at **St Paul's Cathedral, London**. His fiction is rooted in lived experience, delivering authenticity, dark humor, and insight rarely found outside a real detective's career.

Drawing on decades of frontline policing, Powell set out to write crime fiction from a true detective's perspective capturing the banter, resilience, and unspoken realities of police work. Influenced by authors such as **Mark Billingham, Peter James, and Michael Connelly**, Powell brings a distinctly authentic voice shaped by real investigations and real streets.
