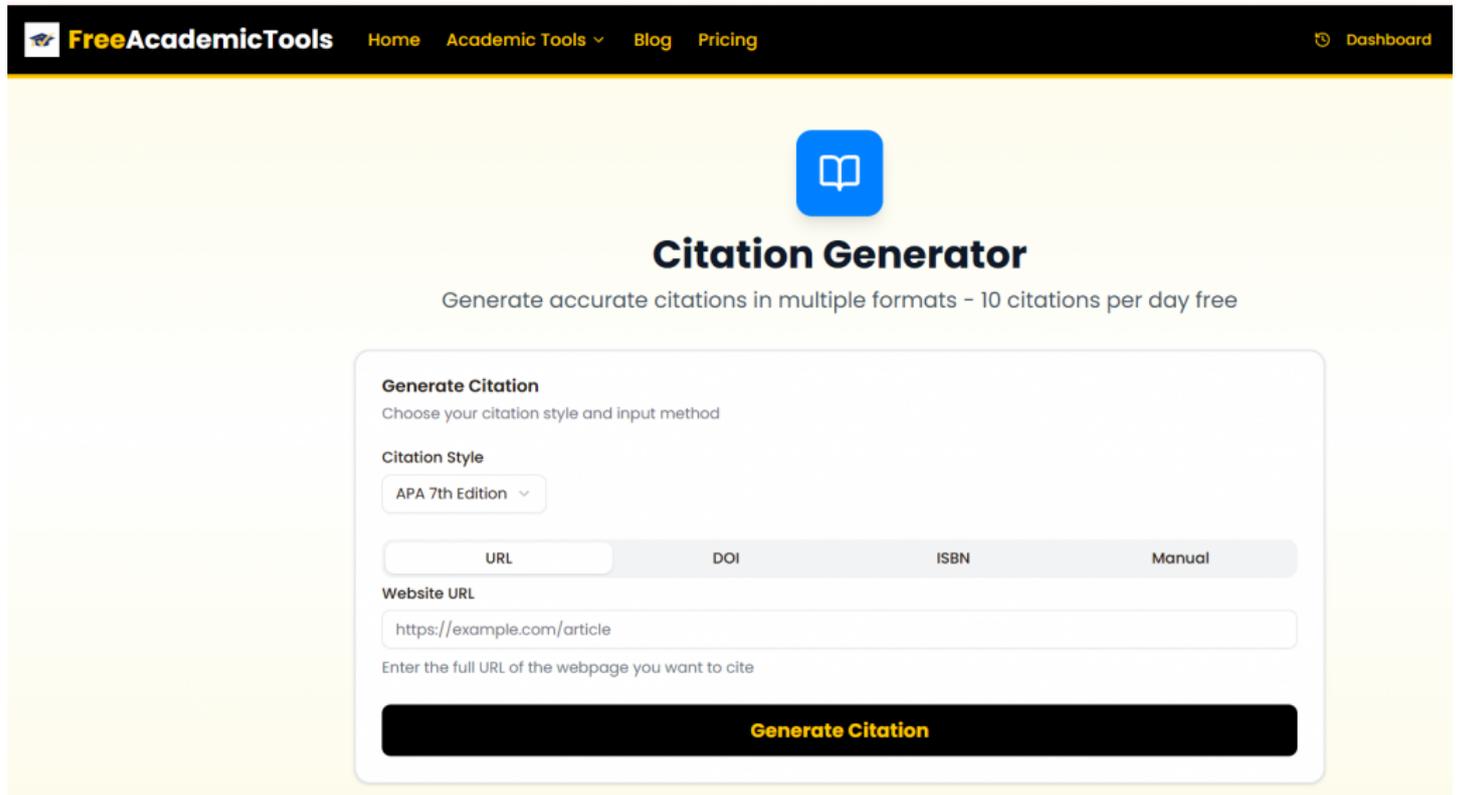


# Free Academic Tools Introduces Free PDF Summarizer and Citation Generator for Students

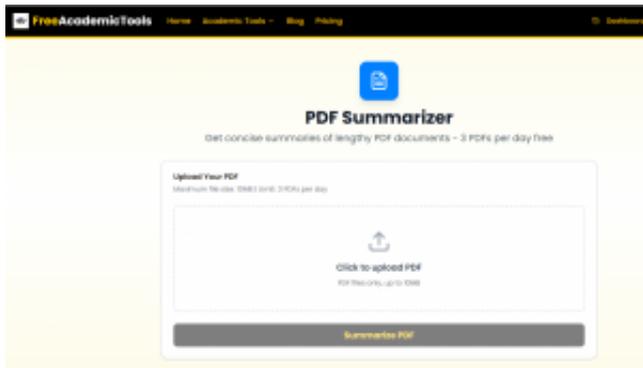
