

Jardim da Paz clarifies the difference between Funeral Plans and Cemetery Plots and reinforces pricing in Curitiba

Educational guidance helps families compare offers fairly—beyond monthly fees—and plan with clarity in Curitiba, Brazil.

Funeral plan vs. plot (jazigo): what changes in practice?

A **funeral plan** is generally a **service and assistance package** designed to support families during a difficult moment. Depending on the plan, it may include operational support, documentation guidance, and funeral-related services. However, families often find that a plan does **not necessarily include a dedicated, permanent burial space**, or that cemetery-related costs may still apply later.

A **cemetery plot (jazigo)** refers to the **right of use** of a dedicated burial space in the cemetery (commonly structured as a contractual “cessão de uso” in Brazil). In practical terms, this is what defines **where** the burial will occur and helps families avoid last-minute uncertainty and unplanned expenses.

“Many families compare offers only by monthly fee, but the most important part is understanding what is actually included—especially whether the offer includes a permanent plot,” said Renato Vidal,

Ombudsman at Jardim da Paz. “Our goal is to make this distinction objective so people can compare properly and make informed decisions.”

Transparent entry pricing: accessible options published online

Jardim da Paz highlights that its website publishes entry prices and installment options to support informed comparison. Current examples include:

- **Jazigo (plots) (2 gavetas):** prices **starting at R\$ 10.900,00**, with installment options described on the website
- **Jazigo (plots) (3 gavetas):** prices **starting at R\$ 15.900,00**, with installment options described on the website

Because prices and conditions are publicly available, Jardim da Paz positions its offerings as **among the most accessible in Curitiba** for families seeking a private cemetery option, and invites consumers to compare total cost and inclusions—not only the monthly fee—when evaluating alternatives.

A practical checklist for comparing offers fairly

To help families evaluate alternatives, the guide recommends checking:

- **Where** the burial will take place (and under what conditions)
- Whether the offer includes a **permanent plot** or only temporary arrangements
- Which fees may apply later (burial space, cemetery fees, transfers, maintenance, etc.)
- What is clearly stated in the contract: coverage, exclusions, timelines, and responsibilities
