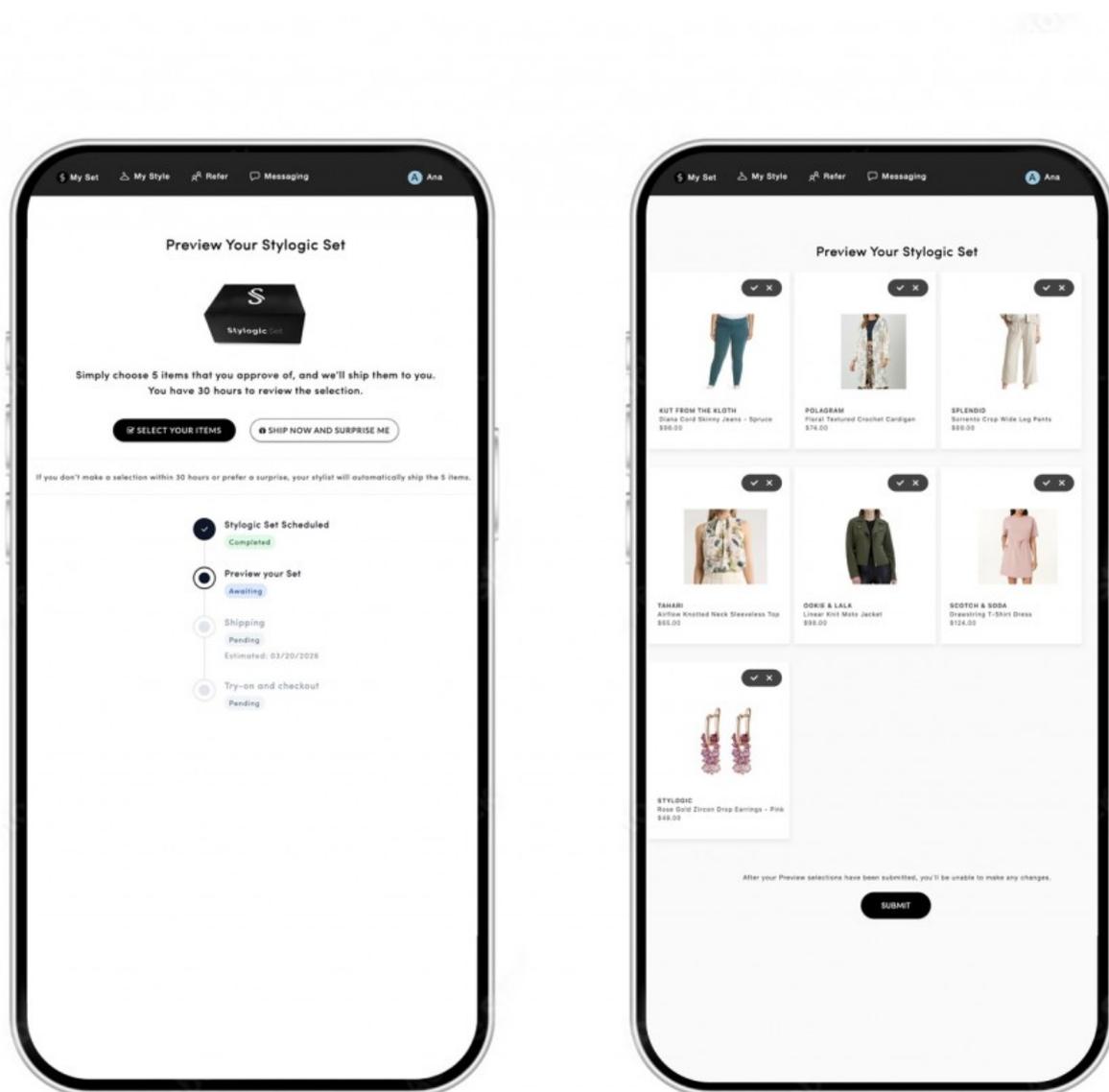


Stylogic to Launch a Preview Feature, Giving Clients More Control Over Their Curated Style Experience
