Built with practising clinicians at its core, the platform is designed for real-world usability in high-pressure healthcare environments. HealthOrbit AI is listed on the NHS Ambient Voice Technology (AVT) Registry, a listing that signals regulatory credibility and has been instrumental in opening doors with NHS-connected trusts and hospital networks internationally.

TRACTION & COMMERCIAL MILESTONES

HealthOrbit AI's fundraising is underpinned by a set of commercial milestones that demonstrate the platform's real-world viability. The company is not raising on the promise of future product development alone, it is raising against a backdrop of active customers, recurring revenue, and institutional engagement. Key milestones include:

- Significant funds raised to date across the wider funding round, including contributions ahead of the Crowdcube campaign launch
- Strong recurring revenue from paying customers across multiple countries
- A growing number of investors have committed to Crowdcube since the campaign opened

INVESTOR OPPORTUNITY & USE OF FUNDS

The capital raised through this round will be used to scale HealthOrbit AI's commercial operations, strengthen its engineering team, and accelerate deployment across existing hospital network partnerships. With the infrastructure and regulatory foundation already in place, the company says it is focused on execution, converting active engagements into contracted deployments and expanding its customer base in existing geographies before entering new markets.

The Crowdcube round is eligible for SEIS and EIS tax relief, providing eligible UK investors with substantial tax advantages on their investment:

- **SEIS (Seed Enterprise Investment Scheme):** Significant income tax relief on the amount invested, plus loss relief and CGT exemption on gains
- **EIS (Enterprise Investment Scheme):** Meaningful income tax relief on the amount invested, with additional CGT deferral benefits
- **Capital Gains Relief:** Zero capital gains tax on qualifying returns from either scheme, subject to HMRC approval

These incentives, combined with the company's existing revenue base and institutional traction, make this round an opportunity for investors to back a revenue-generating health-tech business at an early stage, with meaningful downside protection through the **SEIS** and **EIS** schemes. Investors are

encouraged to seek independent financial advice before committing.
