- Charlotte's estimated population was **943,476** as of July 1, 2024, and the city's population grew **7.9%** from April 1, 2020, to July 1, 2024.
- Between July 1, 2023, and July 1, 2024, Charlotte added **23,423** residents, ranking among the largest population increases in the country over that period.
- Charlotte Douglas International Airport reported **58.8 million** arriving and departing passengers in 2024, a record year, reinforcing how many decisions in the region start with visitors and newcomers looking things up quickly.
- North Carolina saw **38,748** establishment openings and **30,680** closings between March 2023 and March 2024, a reminder that local choices and reputation signals can influence which businesses grow and which struggle.

- **Make one direct contact.** Call or message with one clear question and note how quickly and clearly you get a response.
- **Ask about process.** For high-consideration decisions, request the next steps in plain language (appointment, consultation, service intake).
- **Confirm how issues are handled.** Look for stated support channels (sales vs service, escalation paths, return calls).
- **Protect your time and privacy.** Avoid sharing sensitive personal details in public comment threads when a direct channel exists.
- **Choose one local step and complete it.** A call, a scheduled visit, or a short consultation is often more reliable than another hour of scrolling.

How to find trustworthy local resources

When you need more certainty, look for sources that are accountable and easy to verify:

- **Official business channels** (website, direct phone line, verified social profiles).
- **Government and public resources** for consumer guidance (city, county, and North Carolina consumer protection information).
- **Local business organisations** that publish verified directories and community information.
- **Established dispute and reporting pathways** on major platforms, used alongside direct outreach to the business itself.
- **Documentation habits that reduce confusion:** write down names, dates, and next steps after any call or visit.
