Court Rejects Insurance Company's Attempt to Split Car Accident Case

In addition to strengthening its litigation team, Pisanchyn Law Firm recently secured a favorable procedural ruling in a Lackawanna County car accident case. Acting as a Pennsylvania injury lawyer, the firm opposed an insurance company's attempt to separate negligence claims from underinsured motorist claims in order to divide the case into multiple proceedings.

The Court rejected the insurer's effort to split the claims, allowing both to proceed together. This ruling reinforces important protections for injured drivers throughout Pennsylvania and highlights the importance of experienced representation in complex motor vehicle accident cases.

Underinsured motorist coverage often becomes critical when the at-fault driver lacks sufficient insurance to fully compensate an injured victim. Efforts to fragment claims can increase litigation complexity and create unnecessary delay. The Court's decision affirms that injured drivers have the right to pursue related claims together when appropriate.

ATV Seat Belt Safety Concerns Raise Product Liability Questions

Pisanchyn Law Firm has also been actively educating the public about reported safety concerns involving certain Polaris side-by-side vehicles. In some rollover incidents, seat belts have fail to release properly, potentially trapping occupants inside.

As an [ATV accident lawyer in Pennsylvania](#), the firm has highlighted that rollover accidents can become significantly more dangerous when safety restraints malfunction. The ability to exit a vehicle quickly during an emergency situation can be critical.

ATV and side-by-side vehicles are widely used across rural and recreational areas throughout Northeastern Pennsylvania. When equipment failures contribute to injury, victims may have potential product liability claims in addition to negligence claims against drivers or operators.
