

Vincenzo D'Eletto, Heir to Neapolitan Tailoring, Returns to American Market with Private Ateliers

Today, he emerges not as a manufacturer, but as a **Guardian of Tradition**.

"We have entered an era of aesthetic amnesia," says D'Eletto. "Society has forgotten that a suit is not a uniform; it is armor. It is the physical manifestation of one's intent. My return to the American Market is not to sell garments, but to restore the discipline of the Sartoria."

- **The Cassini Glamour:** Infusing red-carpet-tested elegance into the daily lives of the modern elite.
- **Guerrieri del Tessuto:** Every piece remains handcrafted in Italy by D'Eletto's "Warriors of Cloth," ensuring the survival of 15th-century Neapolitan techniques.
