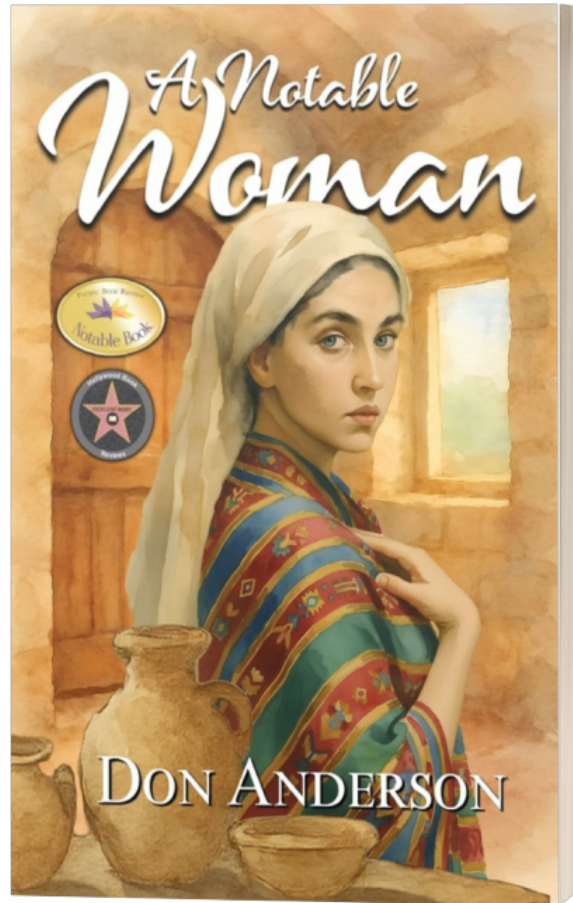


A Notable Woman Reexamines a Quiet Biblical Hero Through History and Culture

The book invites readers to look beyond familiar interpretations and to recognize how ordinary individuals can emerge as extraordinary through faith, wisdom, and perseverance. Anderson presents the woman not as a background character, but as a fully realized figure whose life reflects resilience and spiritual depth.

A Notable Woman will be featured at the LA Times Festival of Books 2026, taking place April 18–19, 2026, at the University of Southern California, and will be showcased at Olympus Story House booth #182 (Gold Zone).
