## Fire Safety Plan Requirements Under Canadian Fire Code

Most commercial, industrial, and multi-residential properties in Canada must maintain an approved fire safety plan under provincial regulations based on the National Fire Code of Canada and the Alberta Fire Code.

These plans require periodic review and updating. Renovations, occupancy changes, new hazard classifications, or modifications to fire protection systems can quickly create gaps between documented procedures and the actual conditions of the building. During inspections, fire departments may request a current plan. When documentation is outdated or unavailable, building owners may face enforcement action or compliance orders.

Activate Fire Safety's fire safety plan consultant team manages the process from initial assessment through final submission and approval.

Each commercial fire safety plan includes:

- supervisory staff roles and responsibilities
- fire prevention procedures
- emergency response protocols
- fire drill schedules and training requirements
- documentation of suppression and detection systems within the property

For facilities with complex occupancies or higher hazard classifications, the engagement may also include emergency response plan services covering incident coordination, communication procedures,

and structured evacuation protocols.

## **Fire Evacuation Plan Preparation as a Core Deliverable**

Fire evacuation planning is treated as a central component of every engagement rather than a secondary task assigned to property managers.

In multi-tenant commercial properties, the plan is developed for the building as a whole. Tenant-level plans alone do not provide the coordinated response structure required under fire code provisions that apply to the entire property.
