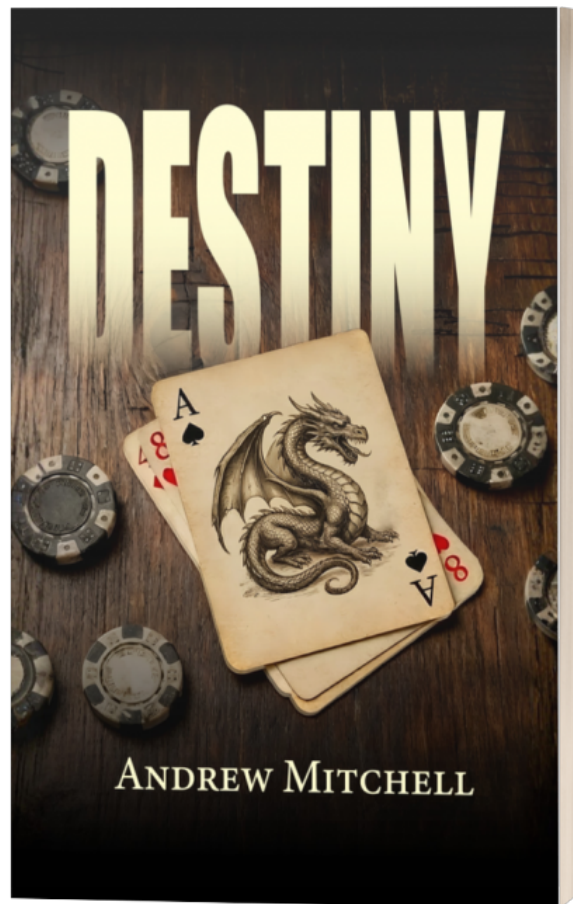


Destiny Brings Frontier Romance and Suspense to Life in the Arizona Territory
