

## ElysianGo Builds Global Umrah Infrastructure Layer as Saudi Vision 2030 Drives Industry Expansion

According to data from Saudi Arabia's General Authority for Statistics (GASTAT), more than 5.4 million pilgrims performed Umrah in a single quarter of 2025, with annual global movement exceeding 15 million pilgrims.

Despite this scale, the industry continues to face structural challenges, including:

- Limited service transparency
- Fragmented coordination across markets
- Inconsistent access to reliable information

ElysianGo addresses these challenges by developing a unified infrastructure that connects:

- Travel operations and workflow systems
- Verified service providers and supply networks
- Cross-border market access
- Multilingual capabilities for global users

"Umrah is not a travel product. It is infrastructure," said a representative from ElysianGo.

"What the industry needs is not more demand — but better structure. Our goal is to enable a coordinated, transparent, and scalable ecosystem."

ElysianGo has already established access across South Asia markets including Pakistan, India, and Sri Lanka, and is expanding into:

- Europe (United Kingdom & Scotland)
- Southeast Asia (Malaysia & Singapore)
- Strategic corridors including Turkey
- Emerging markets in Africa including Nigeria and West Africa

With a global Muslim population exceeding 1.9 billion, the demand for integrated Umrah infrastructure is expected to grow significantly in the coming years.

ElysianGo is positioning itself not just as a service provider, but as a foundational layer for the next generation of global Umrah systems.
