“People don’t always realise how many moving parts there are,” Kahn says. “You’re coordinating delivery, installation, and your own schedule. If one piece slips, the whole plan can change.”

5 Ways to Avoid Renovation Setbacks

1. Confirm Inventory Before You Buy

Not all retailers stock the products they sell. Some place orders with suppliers after the purchase is made.

“We own and warehouse 99% of all the products you see displayed on our website,” Kahn says. “That allows us to ship quickly and avoid extra delays.”

Asking whether a product is physically in stock can help set realistic expectations.

2. Order Materials Before Booking Installers

One of the most common mistakes is scheduling installation before materials arrive.

“We’ve seen people book contractors first, then wait on flooring,” Kahn says. “That’s when timelines start to fall apart.”

Having materials on hand before confirming installation dates reduces risk.

3. Allow Buffer Time for Delivery

Even with fast shipping, unexpected issues can happen. Weather, transit delays, and high demand can all impact delivery.

Experts recommend building in extra time between delivery and installation to avoid last-minute changes.

4. Order Samples Early

Choosing flooring takes time. Waiting too long to review samples can delay the entire project.

“Nothing compares to holding a piece of the actual flooring in your home,” Kahn says. “But you want to get that sample early so you can move forward.”

Early decisions help keep projects on schedule.

5. Communicate Clearly with Suppliers

Understanding delivery timelines, tracking information, and order details is key.

“We double and triple check before any flooring is shipped out,” Kahn says. “We will personally call you to let you know that your flooring has shipped.”

Clear communication helps avoid confusion and keeps everyone aligned.

According to housing data, homeowners are more likely to experience delays during high-demand months due to limited contractor availability and supply chain strain.
