Medellín, Colombia – Vcreativeart16, an international nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting healing through the arts, education, equality, and humanitarian outreach, is announcing a new fundraising campaign to help provide safer housing, home repairs, and essential support for families in West Tanzania.

Since 2019, Vcreativeart16 has worked alongside local partners in Tanzania, helping families through charitable initiatives and community support. The organization has collaborated on a book with a local pastor, created a dedicated YouTube playlist highlighting the community, and continues working to improve lives through education, storytelling, and the arts.

To raise funds, the nonprofit is offering two affordable real estate opportunities:

Property 1 – Medellín, Colombia

A small wood-and-metal home located near UVA de la Armonía Park, approximately one mile from downtown Medellín. The property includes functioning water, electricity, and plumbing. While it requires renovation, it is livable and offers the opportunity to rebuild or expand with additional floors, as many neighboring homes have done.

Price: US\$3,500 (cash purchase).

Property 2 – Meridian, Mississippi, USA

A distressed two-bedroom home situated approximately one mile from downtown Meridian with a large yard. The property may be renovated or rebuilt.

Price: US\$2,000 (cash purchase).

For both properties, legal ownership documents will be prepared by a licensed notary or attorney, with ownership transferred after all required documents are signed and payment has been completed.

Supporters who do not wish to purchase a property may also:

- Donate any amount, including US\$5, US\$100, or US\$500.
- Sponsor housing repairs and food assistance for families in Tanzania.
- Contribute funds toward purchasing a home for a family selected by the nonprofit based on demonstrated need.

Businesses, authors, artists, and donors who support the campaign will receive recognition through Vcreativeart16's media network, including:

- One month of promotional exposure.
- Features in Publishing Trend and Vcreativeart16 Journal.
- Promotion across the organization's social media platforms.
- Opportunities for interviews on the Vcreativeart16 YouTube channel.
- Invitations to submit articles, showcase books and artwork, and collaborate with the nonprofit.

Founded by Vanessa Bush, Vcreativeart16 has spent over a decade promoting authors, artists, and healing through creative expression. The organization has interviewed more than 100 podcast guests, published newsletters twice each month, written more than 20 magazine articles internationally, mentored emerging writers, organized art initiatives, and developed online communities focused on encouragement, healing, and creativity. Its LinkedIn community has grown to more than 10,000 followers, while its YouTube content has reached thousands of viewers worldwide.

Funds raised through this campaign will also help expand scholarships, support authors and artists, organize community events and live auctions, and continue humanitarian work in Tanzania.

"Our mission is simple," said founder Vanessa Bush. "We want people to know that their support creates real change. Whether someone purchases a property, donates, promotes our mission, or becomes part of our creative community, they are helping families build safer futures while supporting artists and writers around the world."

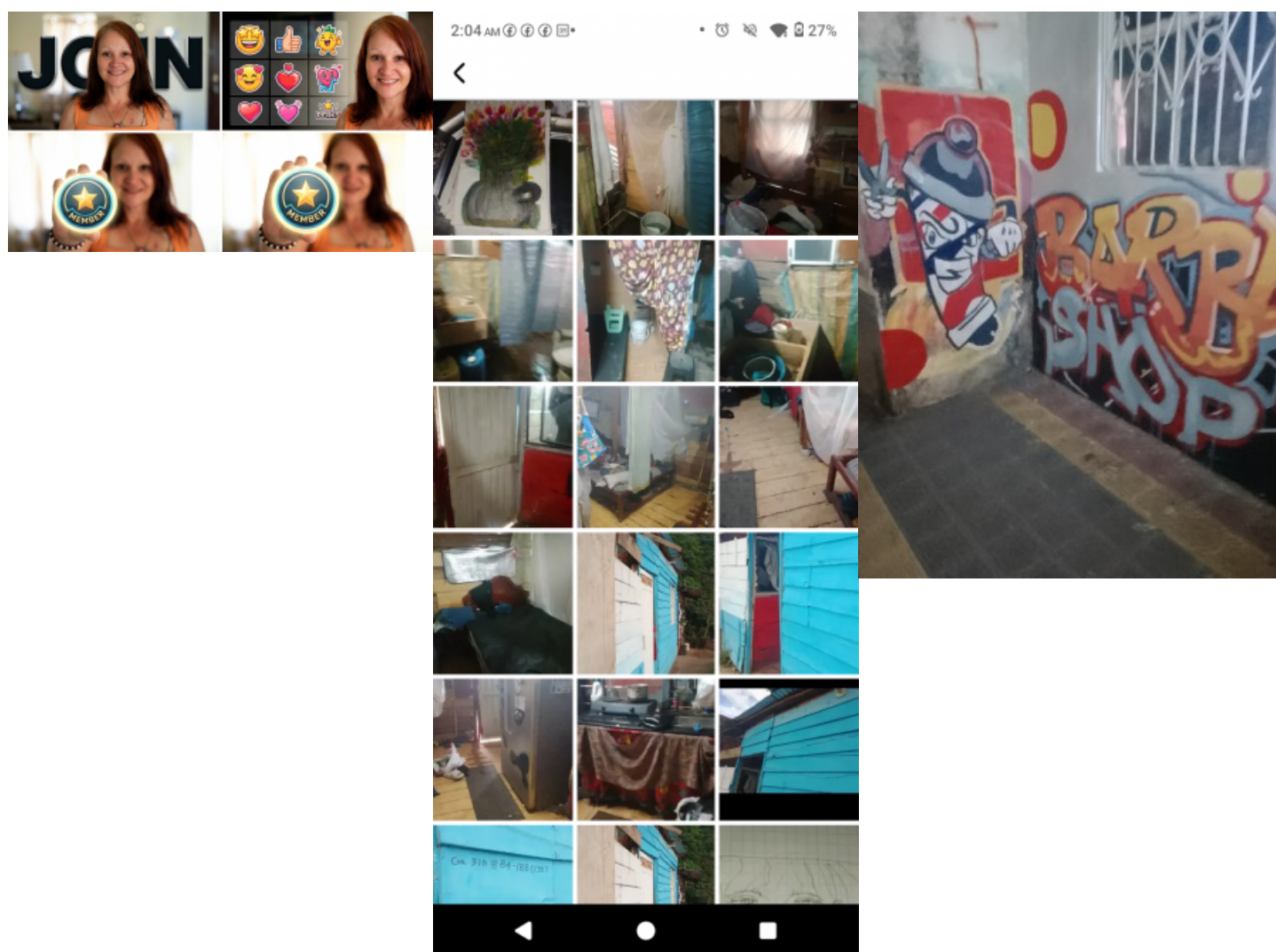
