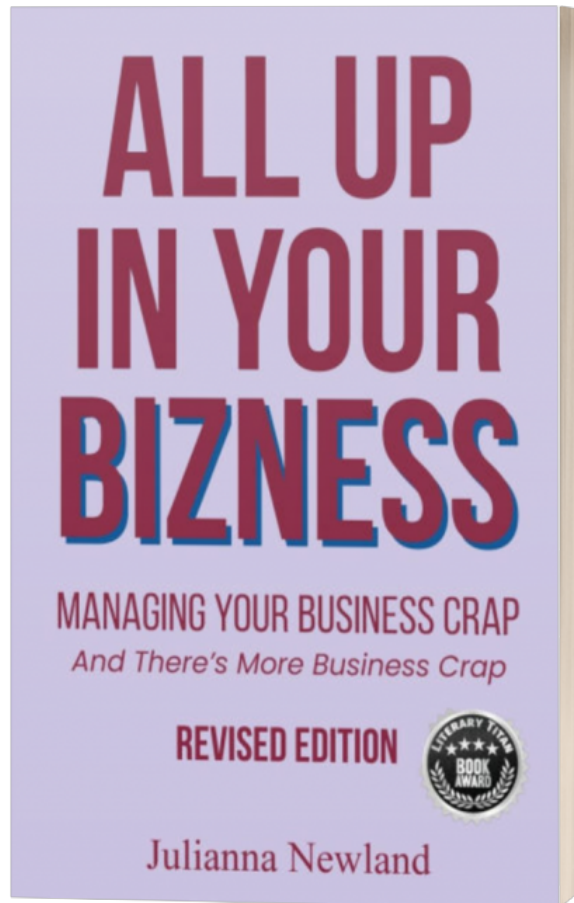


## Julianna Newland’s “All Up in Your Bizness” to Be Featured at the 2026 LA Times Festival of Books
