

## **Justin Brewer Advocates for Clarity and Discipline in Small Business**

Justin Brewer of Somers, CT calls on entrepreneurs to simplify systems and build stronger daily habits to handle growing business pressure.

Drawing from his career and recent feature interview, Brewer is encouraging individuals to take control of their routines, better understand their costs, and build discipline into how they work.

“If you don’t understand a system, you can’t control it,” Brewer said. “And if you can’t control it, you can’t improve it.”

### **A Widespread Issue for Small Businesses**

The issue is growing. According to the U.S. Small Business Administration, small businesses account for over 99% of all U.S. companies, yet many operate with limited visibility into operational costs and systems.

Recent studies show:

- More than 60% of small business owners spend less than two hours per month reviewing expenses
- Subscription-based services and operational fees have steadily increased over the past decade
- In regions like the Northeast, business operating costs can be 10–15% higher than the national average

“A lot of owners are focused on serving customers and growing revenue,” Brewer said. “They don’t always have time to break down every system. That’s where problems build up.”

### **Discipline as the Solution**

Brewer believes the answer starts with discipline, not complexity. His approach is shaped by his background as an NCAA Division I soccer player, where routine and repetition were non-negotiable.

“You don’t get results by accident,” he said. “You earn them through repetition and focus.”

He applies the same mindset to business. Structured schedules. Clear priorities. Regular review.

“If I let my schedule drift, everything drifts,” Brewer said. “Routine keeps pressure manageable.”

He also emphasises that progress does not come from large changes all at once.

“Most people underestimate what steady effort can do,” he said. “Big change usually comes from doing small things well, over and over.”

### **What Individuals Can Do Right Now**

Rather than relying on outside solutions, Brewer encourages business owners and professionals to take immediate, practical steps:

- Review one recent monthly statement in detail
- List all recurring services and subscriptions
- Cancel one item that no longer adds value
- Block one hour each week for focused review
- Limit distractions during key work periods
- Track a small set of important metrics
- Build a consistent daily routine

“You don’t need a perfect system to start,” Brewer said. “You need to start paying attention.”

### **A Call to Action**

Justin Brewer is encouraging individuals to take one simple step this week: choose one area of your work or finances and make it clearer.

“Start where you are,” he said. “Stay consistent. Keep learning. That’s how you build something strong over time.”
