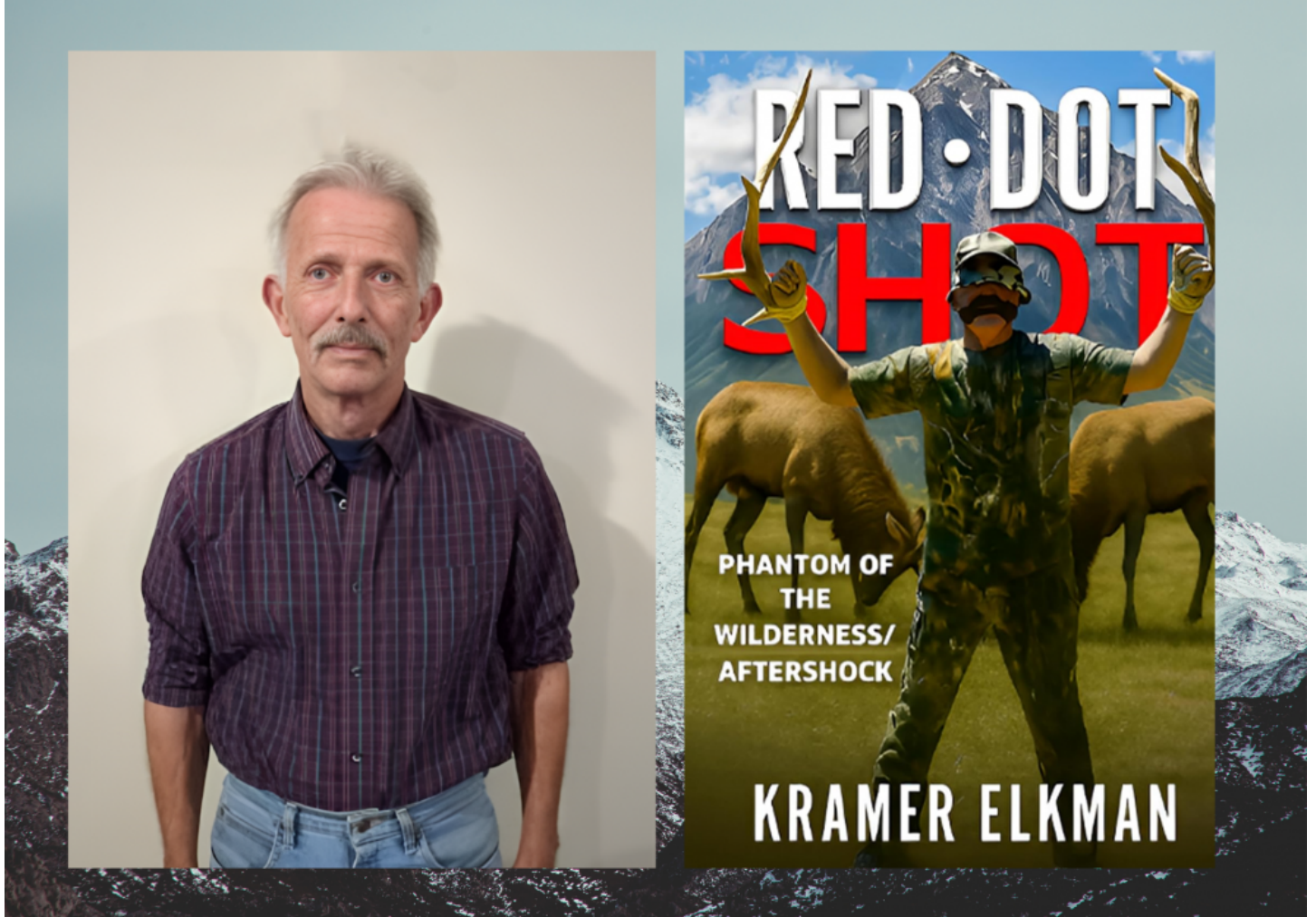


Kramer Elkman Releases Memoir "Red Dot Shot" — A Stark Look at Survival and Consequence
