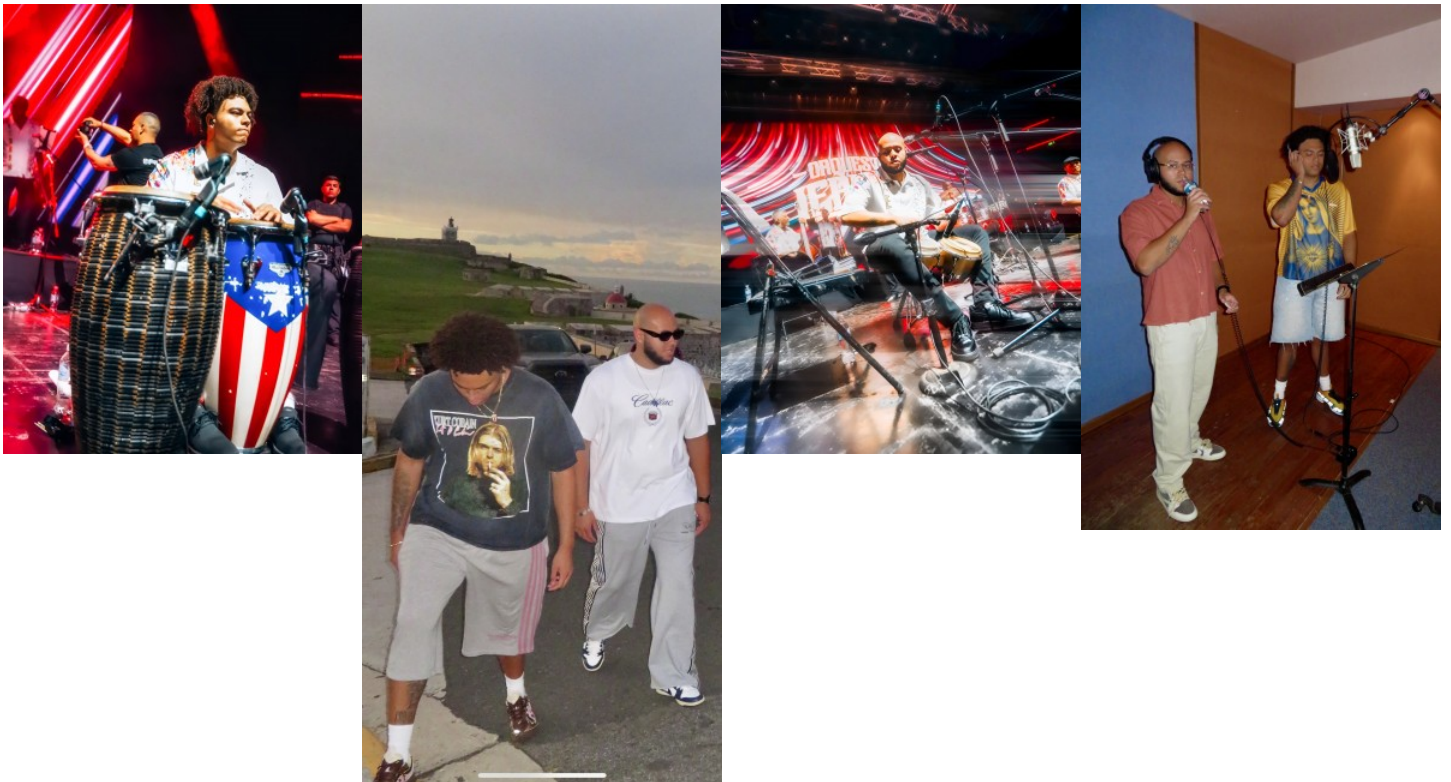
“That cultural and emotional connection brought us back into the studio,” said the duo. “We gave this project everything we had.”
