


Return On Now Launches Free Semantic Markup Tool for Structured Data Generation

New tool simplifies production-ready JSON-LD creation for common schema types through a guided input process

The tool gives users a guided way to create structured data markup for websites by selecting a schema type, completing plain-English form fields, and generating production-ready JSON-LD wrapped in script tags. Users can then copy or download the markup for implementation in a CMS or tag manager.

The Semantic Markup Tool currently supports Organization, Local Business, Person, Article, Blog Post, FAQ Page, and Breadcrumb schema types.

According to Return On Now, the tool was built to simplify a task that often becomes more technical and time-consuming than it should be. Rather than requiring manual review of schema documentation, troubleshooting malformed JSON, or reliance on plugins, the tool focuses on clean output and straightforward implementation.

“Structured data should not slow down your workflow,” said Tommy Landry, founder of Return On Now. “This tool makes it easier to create valid schema markup without wasting time on formatting issues or avoidable errors.”

Users who request access receive full use of the tool, including live JSON-LD preview with script tags and one-click copy functionality.
