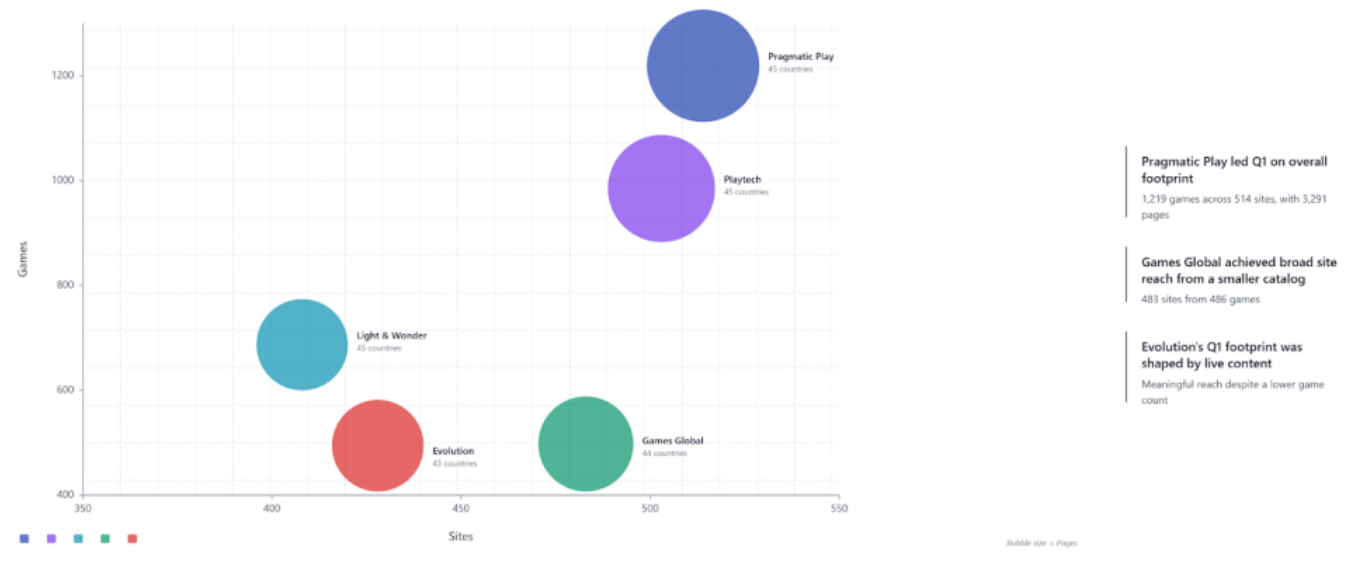


# SlotsRank Reveals Which Slot Providers Actually Dominated Q1 2026

## Q1 2026 Provider Footprint at a Glance

A visual snapshot of provider reach across games, sites, pages, and countries

Brazil, Finland, and the United Kingdom stood out as recurring market drivers in Q1.

**New York City, New York Apr 9, 2026 (Issuewire.com) - SlotsRank** analyzed Q1 2026 data across **3,844 games** and **12,999 pages** to see which slot providers built the strongest footprint across sites, markets, and titles. Among **Pragmatic Play, Playtech, Light & Wonder, Games Global, and Evolution**, Pragmatic Play led the quarter on both catalog size and distribution, while the rest of the field showed very different paths to visibility.

Across our five-provider comparison, Pragmatic Play finished first with 1,219 games, 514 sites, 3,291 pages, and coverage across 45 countries. Playtech followed with 985 games, 503 sites, and 2,993 pages, also across 45 countries. Light & Wonder posted 687 games, 408 sites, and 2,172 pages in 45 countries. Games Global recorded 486 games, 483 sites, and 2,354 pages across 44 countries, while Evolution rounded out the group with 467 games, 428 sites, and 2,189 pages in 43 countries.

Pragmatic Play's lead was supported by a broad title-level reach. Its most widely distributed games

were Big Bass Splash (463 sites, 58 countries), Gates of Olympus (462 sites, 62 countries), and Big Bass Bonanza (453 sites, 56 countries). Its strongest site placements came from Betano in Brazil with 712 games, MobileBet in Finland with 683, and ComeOn in Sweden with 681.

Playtech's top-performing titles were Lucky Panda (203 sites, 46 countries), Buffalo Blitz (178 sites, 50 countries), and Live Mega Fire Blaze Roulette (163 sites, 44 countries). Its strongest site placements came from Betfred in the United Kingdom, with 407 games; Sportium in Spain, with 369; and 888 Casino in the UAE, with 366.

Light & Wonder's most widely distributed titles were 88 Fortunes (140 sites, 41 countries), Huff N Lots Of Puff (137 sites, 38 countries), and Huff N More Puff (133 sites, 38 countries). Its leading site placements came from BetRivers in USA (NJ) with 288 games, Leo Vegas in New Zealand with 271, and Leo Vegas in Finland with 261.

Games Global stood out for broad site reach from a smaller catalog. Its top titles were Immortal Romance (283 sites, 45 countries), Eruption Blaze CashinGo (235 sites, 32 countries), and Area Link Dragon (205 sites, 34 countries). Its top site placements came from Pino Casino in Finland (174 games), Shotz in Norway (168), and Novibet in Ireland (167).

Evolution remained structurally different from the rest of the field because its visibility was driven by live content rather than a slot-heavy catalog. Its strongest titles were Crazy Time Live - Evolution (292 sites, 59 countries), Live Lightning Roulette - Evolution (285 sites, 53 countries), and XXXtreme Lightning Roulette - Evolution (246 sites, 46 countries). Its strongest site placements came from Unibet in the United Kingdom with 259 games, Bingo.com in the United Kingdom with 211, and Mr.Bet in Argentina with 209.

- **Evolution:** Crazy Time Live - Evolution, Live Lightning Roulette - Evolution, XXXtreme Lightning Roulette - Evolution

What stood out most in Q1 was not just who had the largest catalog, but how differently providers converted their portfolios into visibility. Pragmatic Play combined scale with repeat placement across key operators and markets. Playtech maintained a broad and balanced footprint. Light & Wonder leaned on durable title brands. Games Global achieved an unusually wide distribution relative to its catalog size, while Evolution showed that live content can generate strong reach without competing on slot volume alone.

The quarter also highlighted how much regional placement mattered. **Brazil, Finland, Sweden, the United Kingdom, Spain, Ireland, Norway, Argentina, and USA (NJ)** all appeared prominently across the provider-level rankings, showing that provider strength was shaped by recurring market and operator presence as much as by raw title count.

That Q1 pattern is likely to remain important as 2026 continues: the providers with the strongest momentum will not just be the ones releasing more games, but the ones turning their catalogs into repeat visibility across the right sites and markets.
