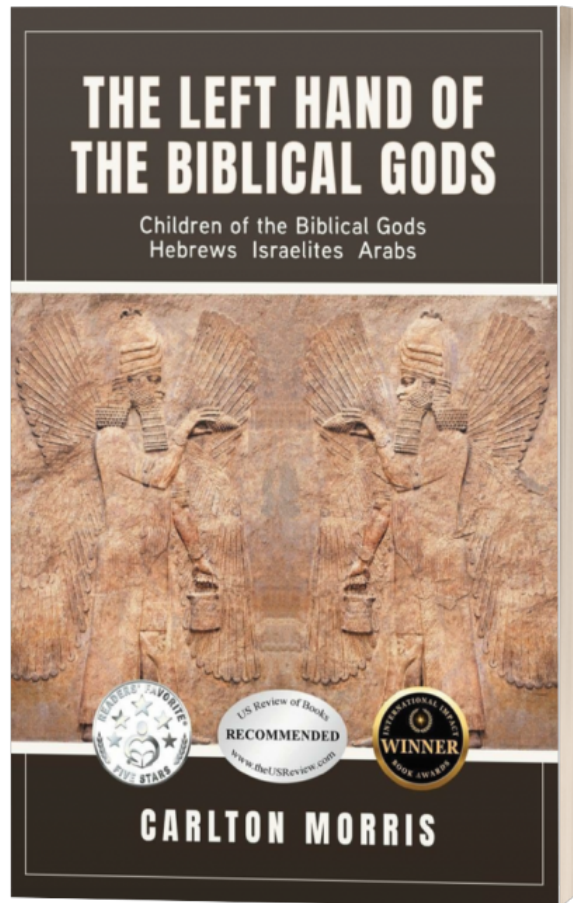


The Left Hand of the Biblical Gods Challenges Traditional Religious Narratives
