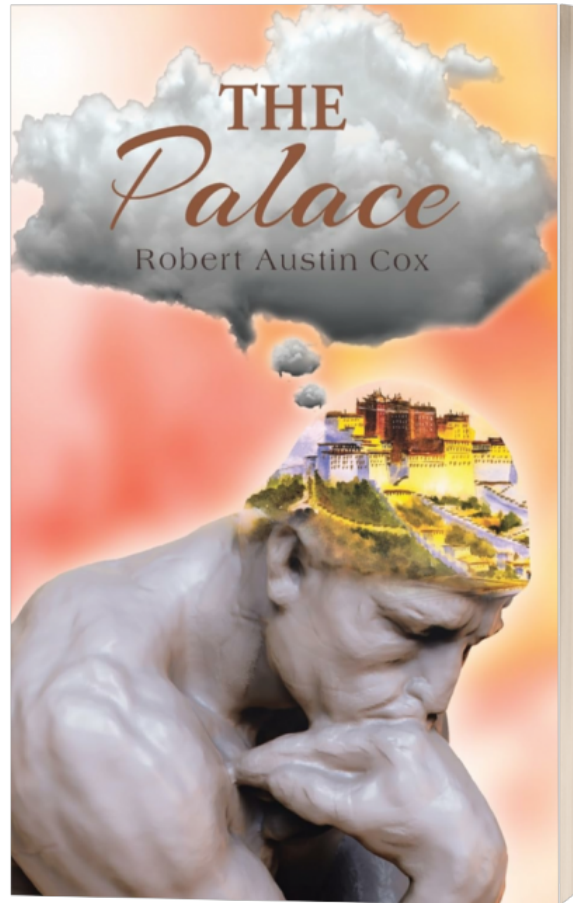


The Palace Blends Adventure, Philosophy, and Self-Discovery in a Thought-Provoking Narrative
