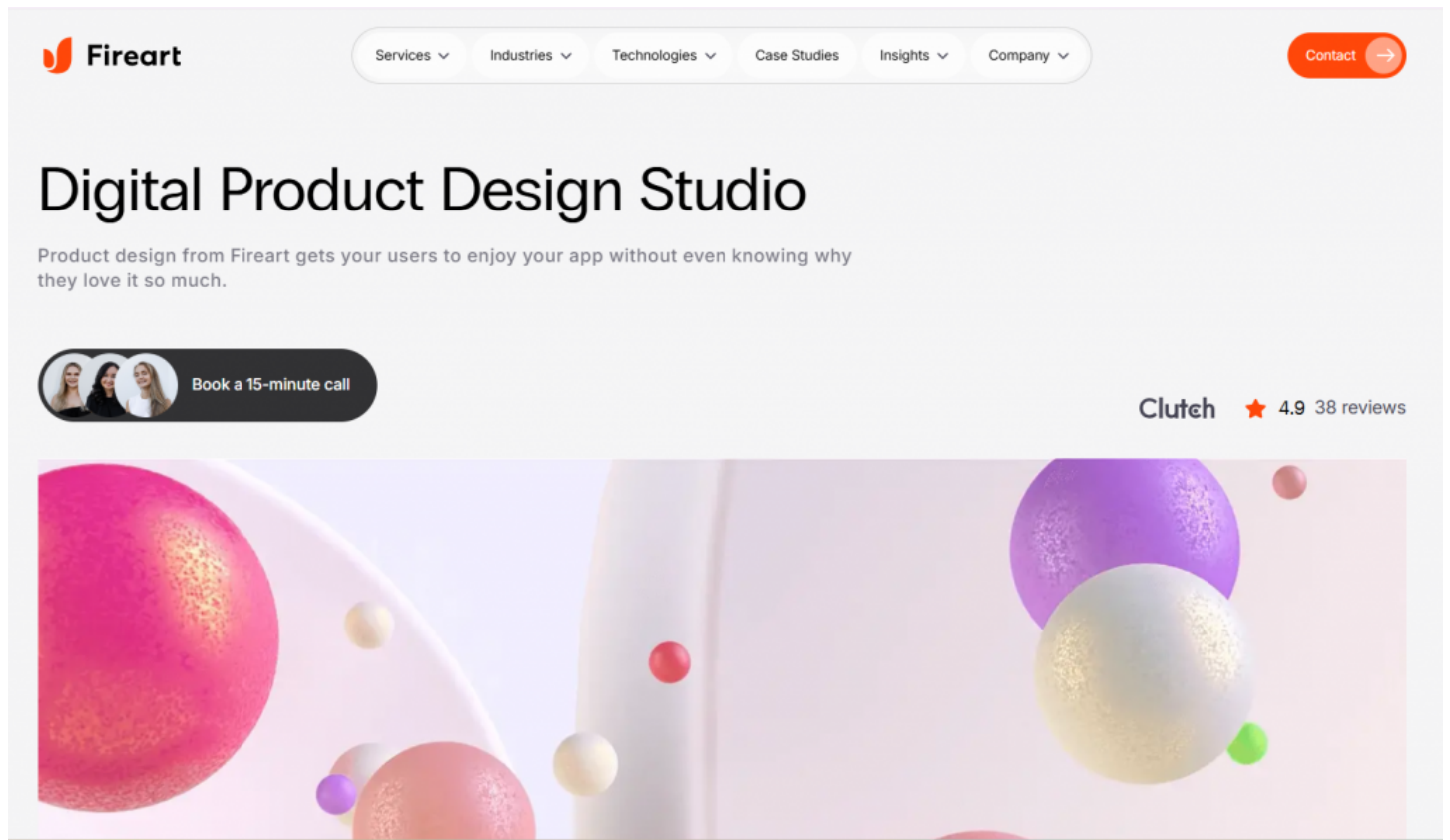


Top 10 Digital Product Design Companies to Hire in 2026

1. Fireart Studio — The Digital Product Design and Development Company Built for Product Teams

Most studios describe themselves as partners. Fireart Studio operates like one. Founded in Warsaw in 2013 with a global client base spanning FinTech, SaaS, healthcare, and e-commerce, the studio has built an integrated design-and-development practice that most agencies claim to have but few actually deliver.

Many firms that call themselves a digital product design and development company are design studios that subcontract engineering, or dev shops where design is an afterthought. Fireart runs both disciplines in parallel — from the first discovery session through final QA and launch.

Who They Are

Fireart Studio works with early-stage startups building their first product and enterprise teams modernizing existing platforms. That dual capacity is rarer than it sounds.
