

Xavier's House Launches as New Nonprofit to Provide Permanent Housing and Employment for Homeless Youth

San Francisco-based 501(c)3 organization acquires and renovates homes in underserved communities, offering permanent rent-free residency, jobs, education, and healthcare to young people with no other options.



San Francisco, California Apr 26, 2026 (IssueWire.com) - Xavier's House, a newly incorporated 501(c)3 nonprofit organization, has officially launched with a mission to provide permanent housing, employment, education, and healthcare to homeless and at-risk youth in America.

The organization operates on a permanent stewardship model: Xavier's House acquires older homes in communities that need revitalization, renovates them with the active participation of older residents who earn wages during the process, and then provides permanent, rent-free residency to young people who have no other housing options. The organization retains ownership of all properties, ensuring each home continues to serve youth for generations.

In addition to stable housing, Xavier's House provides residents with access to job training and employment, GED preparation and college readiness support, vocational certifications, regular medical and dental care, mental health counseling, and recreational and creative programming including art and music.

"We don't run a shelter. We don't offer a program with an end date. We acquire homes, we renovate them with the young people who will live in them, and we make sure those homes are there for as long as they're needed."

Xavier's House was founded by a former licensed general contractor who experienced homelessness firsthand and built a career in construction and engineering before establishing the nonprofit. The organization's founding model reflects that background — combining real estate acquisition,

professional renovation, and comprehensive youth services into a single integrated program.

The organization is currently accepting monthly recurring donations and one-time gifts at xavershouse.org. Xavier's House plans to launch dedicated per-property fundraising campaigns that will allow donors to directly fund the acquisition and renovation of specific homes and track their impact from purchase through occupancy.

Xavier's House is registered as a 501(c)3 public charity. All donations are fully tax-deductible to the extent permitted by law. EIN: 42-1892412.
