What began as informal conversations and support eventually grew into organized group sessions and ultimately evolved into her lifelong calling to help families navigate trauma and adversity.

Through those early experiences, Jeneifer recognized that meaningful healing requires supporting the entire family system rather than focusing solely on one individual. She believes the well-being of children is deeply connected to the emotional and mental wellness of parents and caregivers, a philosophy that continues to guide her therapeutic approach today.

“What I enjoy most about my work is the opportunity to help families heal and grow,” says Jeneifer. “I am passionate about guiding individuals through trauma, supporting mental wellness, and witnessing the resilience and transformation that occur when people receive the right care and encouragement.”

Throughout her career, Jeneifer has remained actively involved in community advocacy and statewide initiatives supporting families impacted by trauma and violence. She currently serves on the Georgia Murder-Suicide Response Network Team and the Georgia Commission on Family Violence, helping provide support, education, and resources to families and communities facing crisis situations.

In addition to her clinical work, Jeneifer has led numerous programs for youth, adolescents, and parents, combining counseling expertise with motivational speaking, mentorship, and educational workshops. Her work emphasizes resilience, self-worth, mental wellness, and practical strategies for healing and personal growth.
