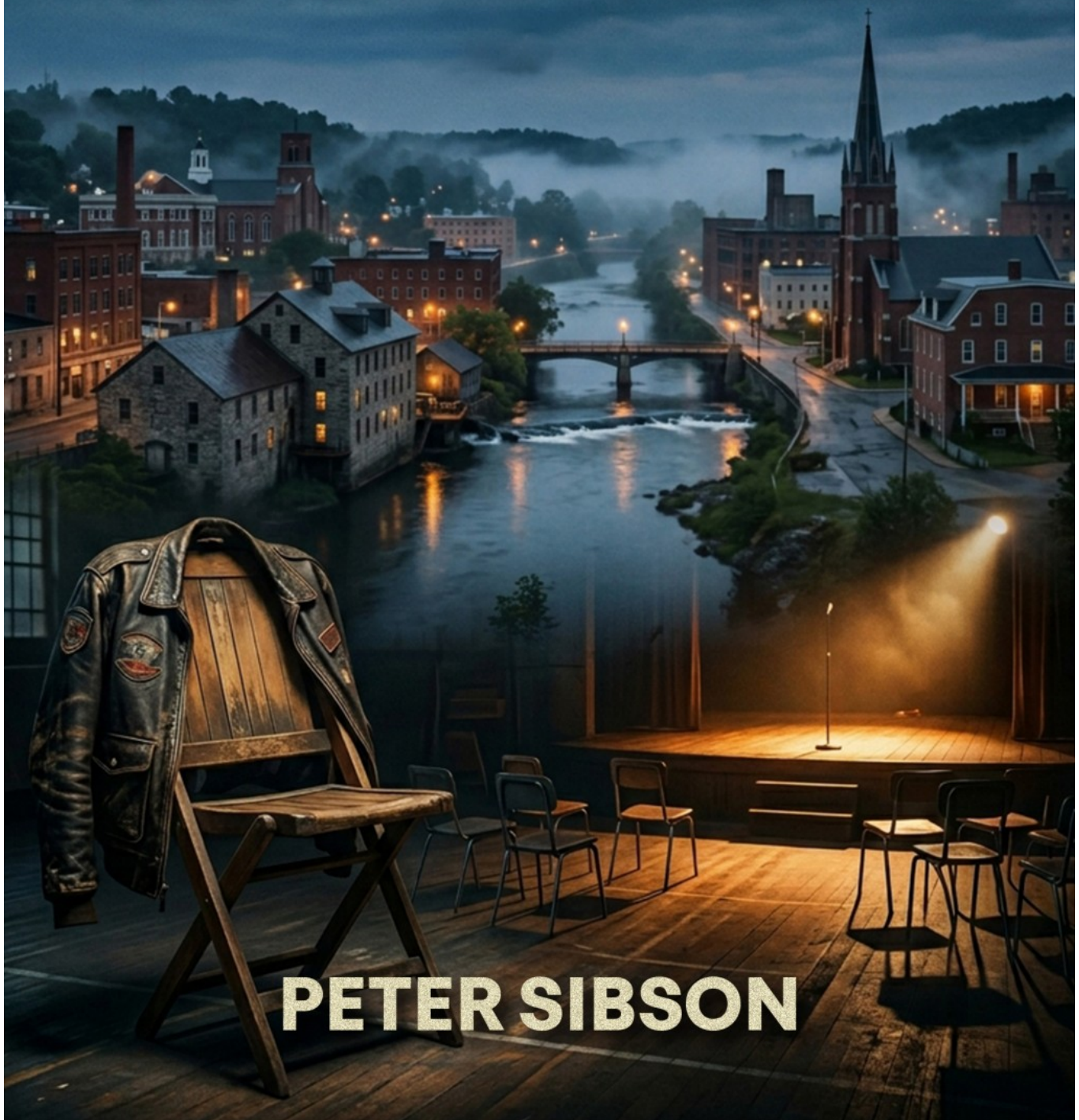


## **Ballad of the Otter: A raw journey through kitchen life, folklore, and the blurred line between reality and spirit**
