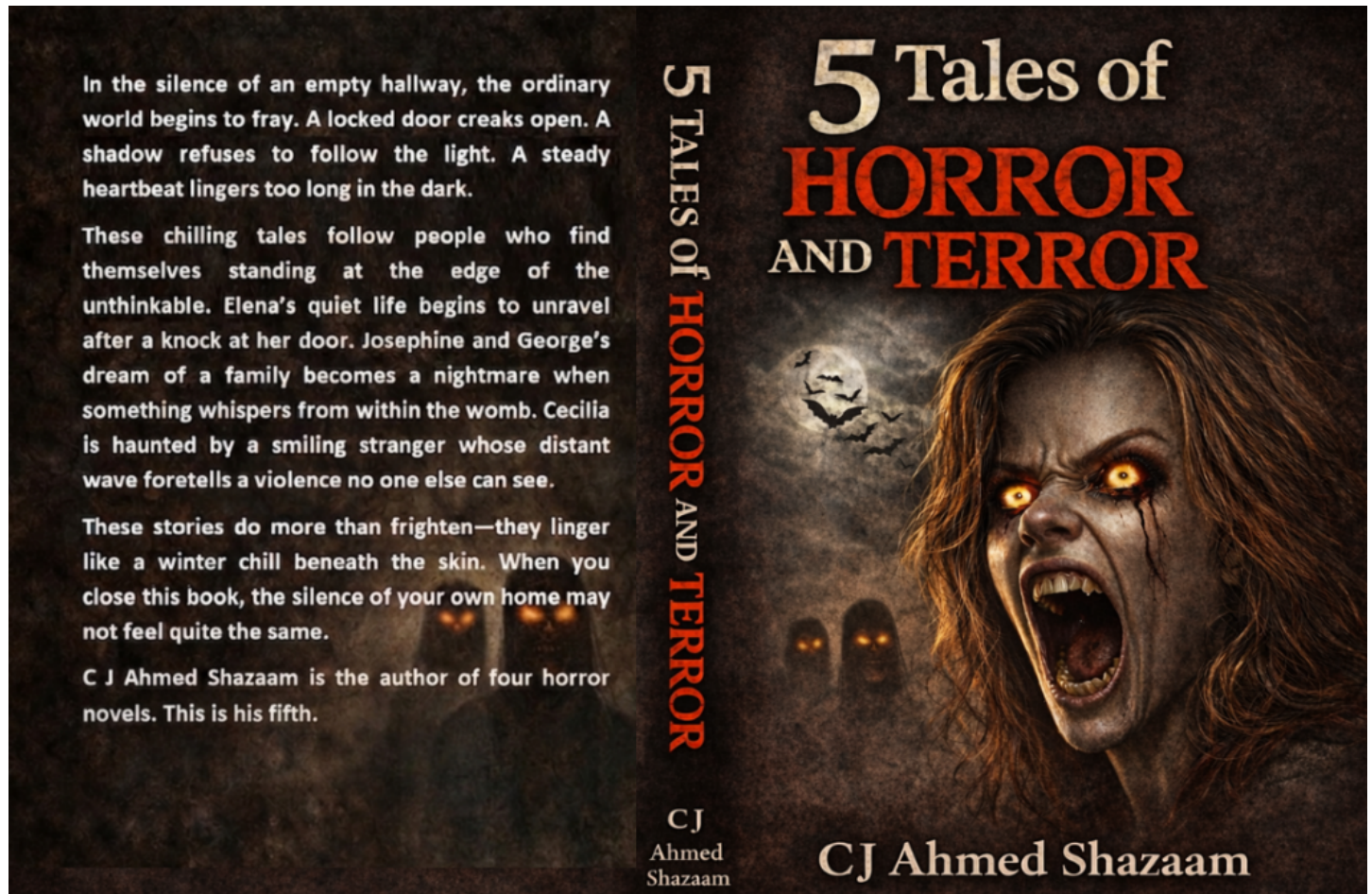


## C.J. Ahmed Shazaam Announces Global Release of “5 Tales of Horror and Terror,” a Psychological Horror Anthology
